STANDARDS

Reading/Writing

- Recognizes the features of a sentence including beginning with capital and ending punctuation.
 - $\circ~$ Uses the features of a sentence by editing sentences with convention errors.
- When given a word can generate a list of rhyming words (words may not contain consonant blends).
- Distinguishes whether the vowel sound is long or short when given a set of singlesyllable spoken words.
- Identifies and says a consonant digraph in a word.
- Says, reads, and spells the digraphs correctly (ch, sh, th, wh, ck, tch).

Math

- Can identify the attributes of a shape and distinguish them as defining (sides, vertices, etc.) and non-defining (color, size, etc.).
 - Can build and draw shapes with defining attributes.
- Can correctly use the strategy of counting on and counting back to solve addition problems within 20.
- Can use fact families for addition and subtraction facts 0-10.

Science

 Understand that sound can make matter vibrate, and vibrating matter can make sound.

Social Studies

• Locate ID, US, continents, and oceans on maps and globes.

Spelling

- /th/ words: bath, moth, this, that, thin, cloth, path, think, thank, math
- /ng/words: king, sing, thing, hang, bang, sang, long, song, hung, sung
- /le/ words: bubble, little, candle, pickle
- Memory words: do, have, show, how, me, a, who, what, when, where, why, which
