Dear St. Anne School Families.

As we begin a new week at St. Anne School, we take a moment to recognize the memorial of St. Leo the Great, Pope and Doctor of the Church, on November 10. St. Leo was a remarkable leader of the early Church whose wisdom, courage, and faith continue to inspire us today. His example reminds us of the importance of strong faith, thoughtful leadership, and compassion - values we strive to live out each day in our school community.

I wanted to take this opportunity to review our safety procedures at the beginning and end of the school day as applied to Hickory Street.

- All drop-off and pick-up should be conducted in one direction, coming up Hickory.
- For morning drop off:
  - If you are dropping your child off in the morning, please pull forward to the playground area before stopping.
  - If you are walking your child to the Community Center door or assisting them out of the car, please pull forward past the playground before stopping.
- For the Hickory Street car line for dismissal
  - Please pull up only to the post that says "Car Line." Anything beyond this sign is reserved for buses, so we ask that cars stop before reaching that point.
  - o Please do not park facing Hickory Street.
  - No child should have to cross Hickory Street to get to their car. This includes cars on Millard Street
  - No one should be getting out on Easton Ave to collect their child. You must wait until the lines move forward and that you're on Hickory Street to get out of your car for your child.

Thank you for your help with keeping our students safe.

#### Dear School Parents:

Hello! My name is Susan Perun, and I am a certified school counselor from Catholic Charities, Diocese of Allentown. Catholic Charities is piloting an exciting new program in several elementary schools this year. Social-emotional skills are such an integral part of student development that we are offering additional social-emotional lessons in the primary grades at St. Anne's School. We are focusing on kindergarten through 4<sup>th</sup> grade to build a foundation from which to grow. Students can benefit from learning social skills, problem solving, coping skills, and feeling management to increase their mental wellness.

Each month I will use short stories, discussions, and group activities, to present topics such as friendship, positivity, listening, empathy, behavior, worrying and more. The class is called STUDO, which stands for STUdent DevelOpment. STUDO also adds a faith-based component to learning developmental tasks. You can reinforce these lessons by asking your children what they have learned in STUDO class. Encourage them to share their experiences and to try different ways of handling situations based on these concepts.


