What is a FID Day

A FID Day is a Flexible Instructional Day where students will learn from home due to inclement weather or an emergency where school is closed. Parents will be notified through the district's calling system.

What is the Virtual Classroom?

Frazier's Virtual Classrooms can be accessed through the teacher landing pages. It is online learning taught by Frazier School District Teachers. Students will log into their Google Classroom and follow their regular schedules as indicated in this document. They will have the opportunity to engage in live, virtual instructional sessions with teachers. Online learning sessions can include, but are not limited to group discussions, activities, and projects.

When would students utilize the Virtual Classroom/ FID option?

Frazier students will be able to utilize the virtual classroom on Flexible Instruction Days (snow/ cold weather) and emergency closures.
