- CFO Alricky Smith and I met with the contractors and February 2023 is the date that advised for us to return the students to Bok North campus.
- Any complaints or concerns please address me with your concerns. This is the best option for us at this time.
- The transportation piece is a challenge but we are going to have to have a little more patience on this concern. We are working on it.
- Jennifer Barrow coordinated our Choose LW Campaign Recruitment Initiative recruiting employees to come and work with LWCS.
- Working with Just Read Florida and New World Read FL went to their conference and also present was Angela Heyward, Stacie Padgett & Principal Kim Griffiths.
- Our students from Bok South ran all the technology for this conference. This was an awesome event for Mr. Rosado and his team.
- We have made 230 home visits. The hurricane affected our visits a little. We are working on getting back on track. Our flyers etc. will also be shared with our Chamber of Commerce and local realtors for Read 20. Our goal is 500 before Christmas.
- We have completed 114 hand written thank you notes to people.
- We have published 29 LW Lead newsletters. This is available to everyone on our electronic Choose Lake Wales site book-shelf.
- We have finished 18 Career Pathways and 5 more in development. Our goal is 100.
- Volleyball won the District & Football has their championship game on Friday night.
- We have two new employees in the Central Office Mr. Andrew Smith for transportation and Dr. Julio Acevedo for our ELL.
- Babson Park had excellent Fall Fest.
- Nurse Marcia Rose is working on our Mental Health initiative for our students.

**Trustee Andy Blair:** The Choose Lake Wales - Marketing Campaign – what are we trying to do?
