As we move into quarter two, the JHW staff and students will begin a deep dive into the Approaches to Learning (ATL) with the International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme. The ATL skills are deliberate strategies, skills and attitudes that permeate the IB teaching and learning environment. The ATLs consist of five categories of interrelated skills and associated sub skills that support students of all ages to become self-regulated learners. The five categories are communication, research, thinking, social skills, and self-management. The teachers will plan for implicit and explicit opportunities using a variety of strategies to develop the ATL both inside and outside the programme of inquiry to influence your child's education not on just what your child learns but how your child learns it.

Finally, we want Janie Howard Wilson to shine with the Lake Wales Charter School Read 20 literacy initiative. Please encourage your child to take an AR test on their reading level. We are going to host a glow party this December. It is important that your child continue to read over the Thanksgiving break, and we encourage you to continue the reading log so your child can take an AR test when he/she returns to campus.






The First Graders are proudly displaying their reading abilities and eager to learn more. The teachers are encouraging the students to read all of their directions twice and re-read as necessary in all subject areas. The students are becoming more responsible for their reading in the ELA block learning the various genres and story elements. In Math, the students are using various manipulatives to solve word problems and computation problems successfully. In Social Studies, the students are becoming more aware of their community and the world around them. In Science, the students are working on various ways to classify matter. So as you can see, our First Graders are very busy at school. Please continue to express the importance of homework and please remember to sign the Sight Word Sentence page.

### Second Grade

Second grade will be working on reading and writing poetry, adding and subtracting 2-digit by 2-digit numbers with and without regrouping. In science and social studies, we will be focusing on "Where we are in place and time." Focusing on pilgrims, Native Americans, and early colonies in Social Studies. In science we will be working matter and its interconnectedness with the world.

### **Third Grade**

We are beginning the 2nd quarter. PLEASE focus on the following with your child:

- 0-12 math facts fluency
- reading daily for 20 minutes & ask clarifying questions
- attendance is mandatory everyday
- dress appropriately for school and weather
- completing homework and turning it in on Fridays

### **Fourth Grade**

Fourth grade has had a great start to the school year. Students worked hard on all of their Beginning of the Year testing. Now the work begins and we are excited to watch our students grow.

As a grade level, students are reading and understanding Informative text. We will also begin to really work on our writing. In Math, students are learning about using patterns to recall multiplication facts, using known multiplication facts to recall other facts and then using this automaticity to solve division facts. We are continuing our study about the State of Florida and wrapping up "Who We Are."

We ask that parents ensure their child is reading, at home, at least 20 minutes a night. Our 4th Grade Teachers appreciate the support from our families! As always, please email or use dojo to contact us for any questions or concerns!

### Fifth Grade

In Fifth Grade for the month of November in Math, the students will be learning to add, subtract, multiply and divide with multidigit numbers and with numbers with decimals. We are continuously practicing our math facts and encourage students and their families to practice them at home. In ELA, we are working on comprehension strategies and skills, making predictions, and singular and plural nouns. Students should be reading at least 20 minutes a day and recording a summary in their reading logs. In Science, we are closing out our unit on the Scientific Method and diving in to Physical Science. In Social Studies, we are finishing our unit on the Constitution and moving on to other historical events that shaped our current forms of government.


