PROVISIONAL Certificate In a Teaching Field (PCTF)



This approach is for non-education majors and can only be pursued in conjunction with an employing Alabama county/city school system or eligible nonpublic/private school.

Three 1 year certificates are available through this approach.

As part of the PCTF approach, the following will be required to attain professional certification:

- Completion of four (4) prescribed courses at an Alabama University with a grade of "C" or above
- A year of full-time teaching experience while holding each Provisional Certificate
- AECAP Assessment: edTPA or PLT as applicable

To be considered for hire under the PCTF approach, you must hold at least a bachelor's degree or higher from an appropriately accredited senior institution with a minimum overall GPA of 2.5 (3.0 GPA for master's degree or higher).

You must also have a passing score on the Alabama prescribed Praxis subject area test or be eligible to pursue the US Armed Forces option.

A Praxis subject area test is not currently available for the teaching fields of Dance, Arabic, Chinese, Italian, Japanese, Korean, and Russian. For these areas, the transcript must show at least 30 semester hours of credit in the teaching field, including 18 hours of upper-division courses.
