### **BOOK SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA**

The recipient of the scholarship shall be a young lady who is a graduating senior.

The scholarship award will be \$500.00 to be given in two installments.

The recipient will have a letter sent from the College or University Registrar's office to the Treasurer of the chapter as verification of enrollment for both the first and second semesters.

The scholarship is awarded to schools based on a schedule of locations for even and odd years per chapter guidelines.

Application shall be submitted by the submission deadline of May 05, 2022.

The application packet must be scanned and submitted **as one file** with the file name (last name, first name TPZ Scholarship year) example (Johnson Liz TPZ Scholarship 2022) and submitted to the following email address: (**[TheTapizetascholarships@gmail.com](mailto:TheTapizetascholarships@gmail.com)**).

A minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 system.

The student will have to submit the following information to complete the application process:

1. A copy of their high school transcript.
2. A copy of the ACT/SAT scores must be submitted with the application.
3. Any other test scores which they think will improve their application.
4. Two (2) character reference letters from any non-relative who has had direct involvement in the student's academic success. One letter should be a reference regarding your academic endeavors and the second letter should be a letter of reference attesting to your community service (civic) endeavors. These references must have known the student for at least two years and their letters states that fact.
5. A one-page essay submission. Entries must be typed, double-spaced, in 12-point Times New Roman font with a one-inch margin on all sides of the page.

#### **\*\* Suggested essay prompts**

- Please detail your community service involvement and explain what it has meant to you.
- Please explain the impact that your volunteerism has had on your school or community.
- Please provide information about yourself, your educational goals, and professional aspirations.
- Please explain how virtual learning impacted your academic success.
