

Transportation changes:




If you ever change the way your child gets home in the afternoon, it is very important for you to let us Know that information as soon as possible. Call the office or text Ms. Massa!

- Graded papers that need to be signed.



Reading/writing

*<u>Phonics:</u> Fundations Phonics- Please pay close attention to the parent letters/homework that comes home in your child's folder. It explains how we teach each skill and how you can help at home.

<u>Reading</u>: This year we are reading stories from the CKLA program. The students will also be reading passages and books on their level. When reading books at home, make sure you are asking the students questions about what happened in the story, who the characters are, and where the story takes place (setting). You can also ask things like "how would you feel if that happened to you?" "how do you think the characters felt?" "would you react the same way?"

<u>Writing:</u> Practice, Practice, Practice! To help with writing at home, you can have students write about anything! Show them a picture, ask them about a memory, write about a family member, let them help you make a grocery list, write a letter/card. Be sure to use proper punctuation and capital letters!
