Morning Drop-Off Procedures

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we continue to make adjustments to our arrival and dismissal procedures. Please follow these procedures until further notice.

Parent drop-off will not open until 7:30 a.m. Please do not drop students off prior to that time.

Buses will drop students off at the front of the school. Buses will begin unloading at approximately 7:35 a.m. and should depart the front of the building by approximately 7:40 a.m. Parents entering from 3rd Street should proceed to the stop sign at Ohio Street, then head south on Ohio Street, and turn left onto School Drive.

Parents should continue on School Drive and enter the school parking lot.

Please drop students off near the first row of the parking lot. After dropping off your student, please continue through the parking lot and exit onto 3rd Street.

Once the buses have unloaded and departed from the front of the school, parents may proceed directly to the front of the school for student drop-off.

Please use extra caution while entering and exiting the school property, as we will have both buses and students moving through the front of the building during this time.

Afternoon Pick-Up

Our elementary students are dismissed at 2:30 p.m., while junior high and high school students are dismissed at 2:40 p.m. If you are picking up a junior high or high school student, we ask that you please do not arrive too early.

Allowing our elementary parents to be first in line will help them pick up their students and exit the school grounds before our junior high and high school dismissal begins.

Parents should continue to use School Drive and the parking lot for afternoon pick-up as well. Please stay left on the lane, so the buses can use the right side to get to the front of the school.

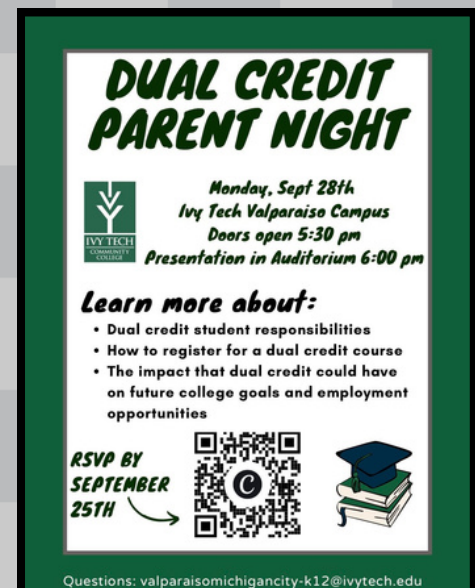
