Elementary TALENT SHOW will be on Friday, May 10th this year. Any student in 3rd through 5th grade may audition their act. No act is guaranteed with this sign up form. All acts audition.

*This SIGN UP form is due any time before Friday, 4/26.

*Auditions with judges for ALL acts will be held during the school day in our WIN time 4/22 - 5/2 based on testing, field trip schedules, and if students are ready. Sign-ups for times will be done with Mrs. Jezek and will be coordinated with grade level teachers and not interfere with testing days.

*This is an optional activity.

Those interested in performing an act in the Talent Show must READ THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES along with their parents and have a parent/guardian sign the permission slip to audition (Students may not audition without having this completed).

Important Info

If the panel of judges feels the act is not prepared or not quite ready to perform in front of an audience, they will not be selected to perform in this year's talent show. This event is meant to encourage performance of well-prepared individuals for all types of acts. Our audition panel does not want to put a kiddo in a position to be on stage and not be ready, to be overly nervous, or not feel at their best.

PROCEDURES:

- *The audition must be EXACTLY like the act would be performed IF chosen for the actual talent show (includes attire, music, everything).
- 1. A variety of acts are encouraged—singing, playing a musical instrument, dancing, performing in a skit, doing magic tricks, performing stand-up comedy, juggling, or any other unique talent!
- 2. All performers must be Slidell ISD students.
- 3. All acts must be LESS THAN 5 minutes.
- 4. Students may only perform in two different acts, maximum.
- 5. All lyrics/music/acts must be school appropriate and tasteful in every way. This includes any song being sung, performed by an instrumentalist, or danced to. Also pertains to theme of any act.
- 6. All acts must be FULLY PREPARED FOR THE AUDITION—words memorized, choreography completed, costumes ready, etc.
- 7. You should NOT be lip-synching to a song. We want to hear your voice.
- 8. If recorded accompaniment is being used, student must have mp3 track on personal device or know the SPECIFIC YouTube link/video when they arrive at their audition. We will have an aux cord available to plug their device into the speakers OR be able to pull up their song on YouTube if they know the exact video.
