### Mrs. Hanna's TK - 3rd Grade



This has been another amazing week full of discovery and fun activities.

In science this week the title of the lesson is, "Why does a can of soda sometimes explode when you open it?" Learning about why a soda can sometimes explodes is relevant in a unit about weather because it is a tangible and relatable introduction to air pressure. The students learn what is necessary and how they can mix something that is a liquid (water) and gas (carbon dioxide) and they observe what happens when it is mixed together.

In social studies, we are delving deeper into maps, being able to understand parts of maps and how to read a map grid. The students have been very quick to understand map grids and how to use them. I am very happy to see this! It just might come in handy sometime that they know how to read a map. When they have a map in front of them, they can find where they are and figure out where they need to be going and how to get there!

For math it's spread out all over the place this week. In kindergarten they are learning composite shapes, how to see them and patterns - what goes next with specific patterns. In first grade they are learning about picture graphs and how to use tally charts. In second grade they are learning about measuring. Sometimes we use meters and centimeters. Sometimes we use inches, feet and yards. They are also learning how to find the perimeter. In third grade they are continuing on division- by 1 through 12. They are also learning tic-tac-toe division, word problems and multiplying and dividing together. I am impressed with how all of the grades are doing and picking up so many new concepts!

In language arts, kindergarten is learning about sentences and ending punctuation. In first grade language arts they are learning about nouns and proper nouns. What are adjectives and verbs and how to recognize all of them. In second grade, they are also learning how to find common nouns in a paragraph. They are also learning about pronouns, reflexive pronouns or indefinite pronouns. They are also learning about adjectives and adverbs and how to identify them. In third grade the students are learning about identifying and how to correctly punctuate a title and dialogue.

This has been a fun week to do extra activities because we've had Saint Patrick's Day at the beginning of the week and on Thursday we had the first day of spring so we had to celebrate that as well! All the students made crowns that they decorated and wore as they went home.

Every day is a gift when we get to learn and grow together! Enjoy today! Mrs. Hanna


