Dr. Barbour reviewed the beginning of the school year, including student enrollment numbers, student demographics, staff hires, and 21-22 school data. A data summary document was distributed and reviewed with the council, including graduation rates, End of Course exam data, MAP Growth data, AP exam data, and EOPA data. She additionally reviewed growth in student participation in student activities, and school operational procedures returning to traditional illness protocols for COVID related illnesses. School activities have resumed without restrictions.

A copy of the 22-23 SMOSS document for VHS was distributed and reviewed. Dr. Barbour reviewed each of the focus areas (Literacy, Math Proficiency, College and Career Readiness, Safety, Attendance, and On Track for Success). She additionally discussed the historical data on the document and the pre-set goals. Strategies for each were identified and discussed.

• Facilities update

Dr. Barbour discussed the completion of the new addition, including 60+ classroom spaces and the multipurpose facility. She stated that the downstairs only was utilized for this school year, including science and CTAE classes. She also discussed the addition of the Early Childhood Education pathway and the lab space for that pathway. Dr. Barbour stated that other classrooms would be utilized with continued growth. Dr. Barbour stated after the adjournment, she would take the parent representatives on a tour of the new addition.
