<u>Literacy Act</u>- What is the ALABAMA LITERACY ACT? The Alabama Literacy Act was passed in 2019 to help improve reading in Alabama public schools to ensure students are reading on grade level by the end of the 3rd grade. Reading is the gateway to lifelong achievement and the students of Alabama deserve a strong start on their path to success.

<u>Numeracy Act</u>: Every Alabama child needs foundational math skills to be successful in career and life. The 2022 Alabama Numeracy Act is the state's comprehensive plan to improve math instruction and support for all students and teachers. This Act has 3 steps. Step 1-Identifying Struggling Schools August 2022- Step 2-Providing Intensive Support Beginning August 2023, Step 3- Accountability and State Academic Intervention-Beginning August 2026.
