STUDENT REGISTRATION FOR 21-22 SCHOOL YEAR

END OF YEAR

In-person students will attend on the day that they are at school. CDL and Thrive students are welcome to join on either day. Just make sure to check-in at the front office upon arrival.

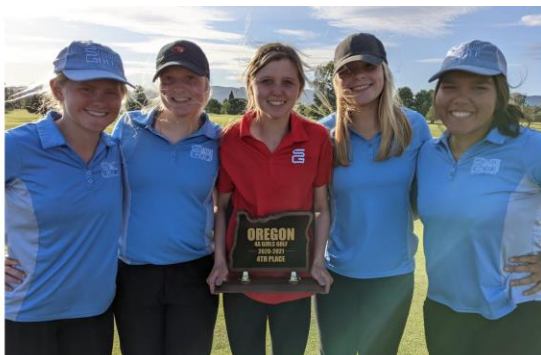
This event is open to students only.

SPORTS PHYSICALS

- Providence Seaside Clinic: (503) 717-7060 only accepting current patients, cost is based on insurance, with Oregon Health Plan it is free
- Northwest Urgent Clinic (Astoria): (503) 325-0333 cost is \$40, walk in only
- Toyas Chiropractic: (503) 738-8900 cost is \$25, an appointment is required
