- A. Charleen's Family photo session. Check into Charleen's availability and then reach out to families with what would be entailed. Perhaps send a survey to check for overall interest.
- B. Parent & teacher photo submissions for yearbook. Parents can submit photos of special activities for the yearbook. Specifically has to be students who are part of Stevens School. Sandy Fravel has also sent an email to teachers to be able to get any class photos that may have been taken throughout the school year.
- C. Munson's spring fundraiser- This will run April 8-22. It will be completely virtual. Links will be shared on social media and Ben will send to Wendy to include in the newsletter. Ben has offered to pick the orders up to save the school on the shipping cost. We will let parents know that they should not expect to buy items to have for Easter.

- G. Spring book fair- This is school, not PTO hosted. Library department is coordinating. Discussed how this would operate in terms of the PTO reimbursing the school as the PTO is the operator of the Scholastic Account. A motion was made by Megan Cancelliere to allow teachers to use \$20 for their classroom library and seconded by Kelly Zotti. Motion passed.
- H. Field day t-shirts, artwork contest deadline 3/18. Votes will happen after the designs are submitted. Third graders are

doing the design submissions but the whole student body will be involved in the voting process. Artwork will be hung in the hallway by the art room. Budgeted for 415 shirts. Amy will send a check to the company for the t-shirts.
