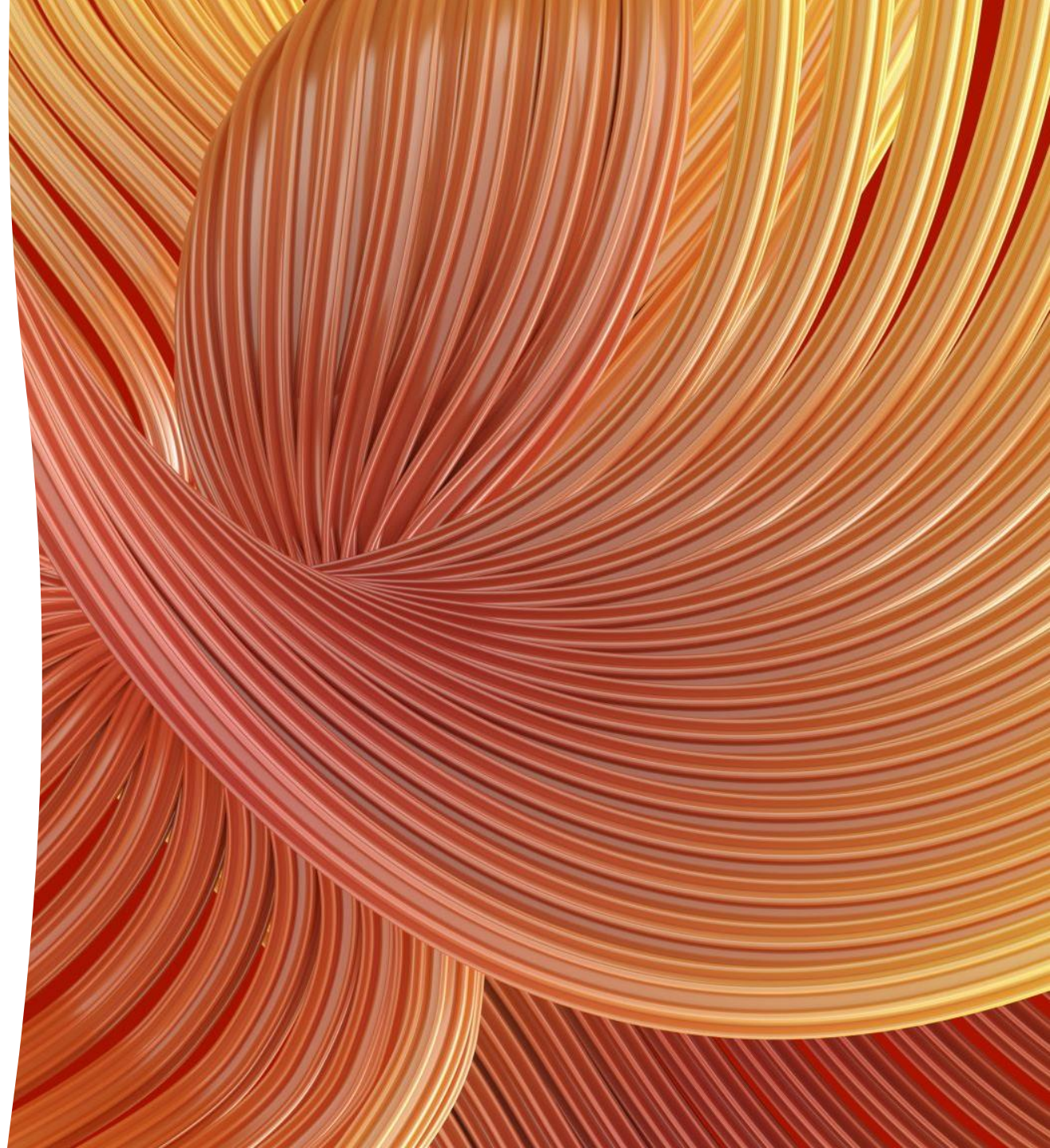
Who Are We?

I love working with the ESOL students and I want to always do MY best to help them learn as much as they can.



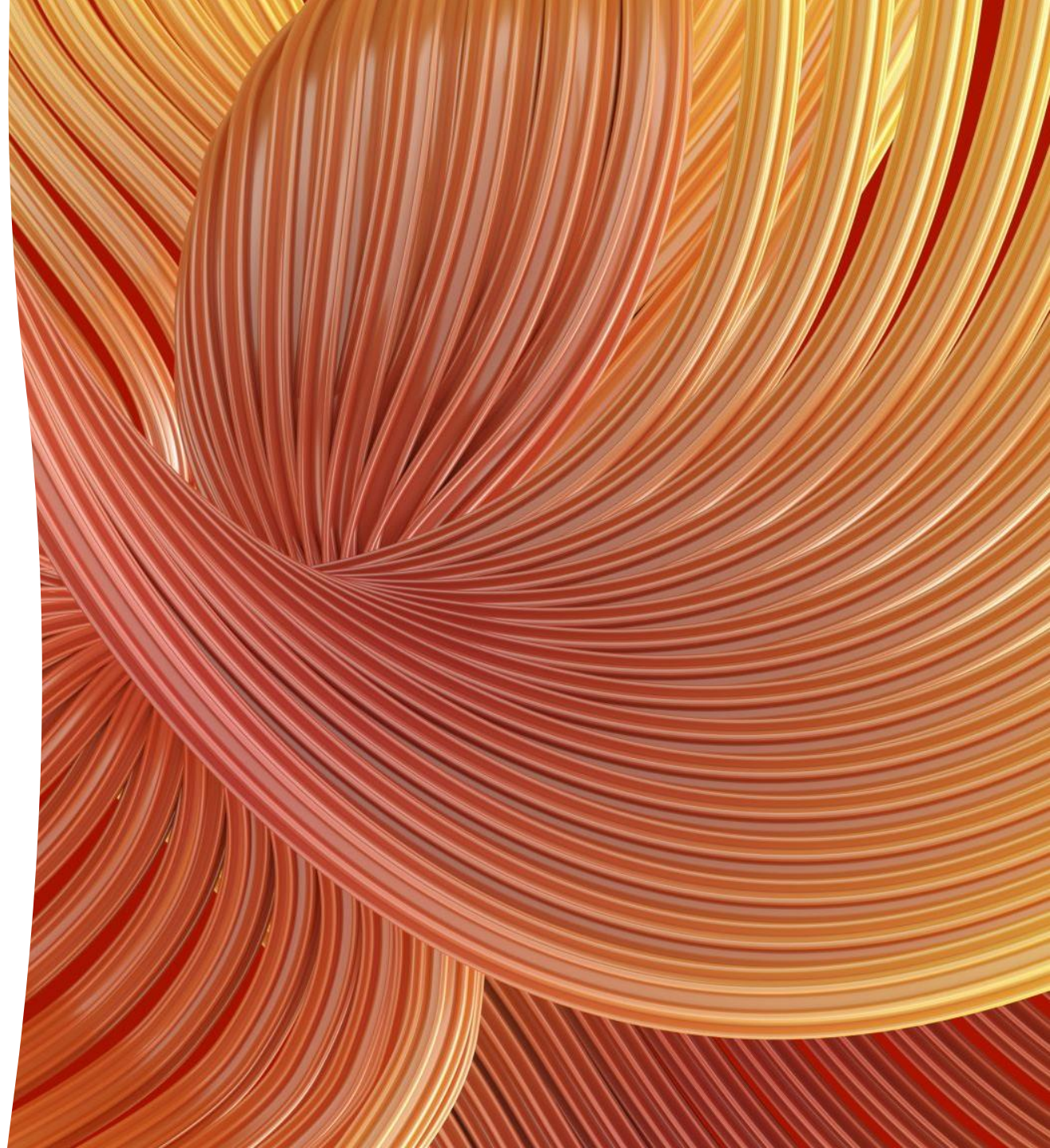
Who Are We?

The ESOL Program

The ESOL Program is a program for students who have a first language that is different from English. There are students from many different countries within the ESOL program.

The goal of the ESOL program is to provide support for students in class in the English language and for students to acquire more and more English as they move from year to year.

As the ESOL teacher, we go into many classes to help students both with the language and the content.

Listen to music in English – students want to be able to sing the words of songs. If they listen to songs they like in English, they will also begin to pick up the language as well.

Watch tv in English and use the subtitles - Using subtitles will help students begin to read in English. But it's also helpful because as they begin to hear the language, they're also learning to see how those words look.

Change the language settings on all your devices – doing this will really push students into learning the language because often when the language settings are changed, it becomes difficult to change it back. As a result you have to learn the language to figure out how to revert the settings.

Listen to podcasts or radio shows (such as the news, sportscasts, etc.)

Play vocabulary games – doing this will increase their English vocabulary

How can you help your student with homework?



Remind them about the homework and encourage them to do it.



Contact the school and the teachers to find out what your student is learning and what they should be doing at home.



If possible, provide a space at home that is quiet and allows them to concentrate.



Find a tutor or ask someone who speaks English to try to help your student understand more.

Graduation Requirements

- The state of Georgia has required that each student acquire 24 credits for graduation.
- Credits are points given to students who pass their classes with a C or higher. A student will earn .5 credit for each class at the end of each semester. At the end of the semester, if a student has passed all classes with a C or higher, they should have earned 3.5 credits for a semester.
- Students who earn 5 credits will be considered a tenth grader.
- Students who earn 11 credits will be considered an eleventh grader.
- Students who earn 17 credits will be considered a twelfth grader.
- Students who earn 24 credits are eligible for graduation.






