Situated in the geographic center of North Carolina, Eastern Randolph High School is a rural, public, consolidated high school serving grades nine through twelve. Founded in 1968, Eastern Randolph High currently serves the communities of Coleridge, Franklinville, and Ramseur. ERHS operates on a ninety-four-minute block schedule with students taking four courses in the fall and four different courses in the spring. The school is located twenty-six miles southeast of Greensboro. The school is in close proximity to Siler City, Asheboro, and Greensboro.
