The Fannin County Board of Education met in a work session with the following members present: Steve Stanley, Vice-Chair; Bobby Bearden; and Lewis DeWeese. Sandra Mercier, Chair and Terry Bramlett were absent due to the annual Georgia Farm Bureau meeting in Jekyll Island, GA.

Tara Cantrell, Fannin County School System Social Worker, reviewed Fannin County School system homeless procedures with Board members.

Art Hubbard, Assistant Superintendent, gave Board members an update on construction projects. Mr. Hubbard stated the geo-piers have been installed and the form work will start within the week on the new maintenance facility. Mr. Hubbard also stated the perimeter footers have been poured, the exterior foundation wall has been poured, the exterior CMU wall has been constructed, and the interior footer excavation is, the plumbing rough, and the electrical rough are all underway at the new CTAE wing.

Mark Henson, Superintendent, reviewed the agenda for the meeting on Thursday, December 12, 2013.

Mr. Henson stated State School Superintendent, Dr. John Barge will be visiting Fannin County High School on Friday, December 13, 2013 from 10:30 to 11:40. Mr. Henson stated there would be an opportunity for the press to take pictures at 11:30. Mr. Henson encouraged the media to attend.

Lewis DeWeese stated when he was doing the Superintendent's evaluation he noticed where Mark Henson's goal was to achieve 99.99% completion.
