Create a more welcoming work environment for all staff members that is supportive of everyone's hard work and individualized duties. I would like a school board that is supportive of the school staff and all that they do for the students and the community. I would like to see more respect for one another among all school staff and board members. A zero tolerance for bullying should be the expectation for students and staff.

The superintendent and principal being the same position, needs to be changed. Superintendent does the super. job and principal focuses on principal duties. Also, I think we need a full time social worker. Mrs. Murphy is a huge asset to our school and we cannot operate without tier two behavior support. With our student dynamic, we also need a full time school counselor who doesn't have any other duties or responsibilities besides the mental



health of our neediest students.

I would also like to see more lanes and steps on the pay scale.

Full-time principal AND a superintendent.

Full-time counselor not sidetracked with other priorities.

More transparent use of money to pay employees that is known and approved by the board. More transparent work overall for all who are concerned or involved There has been some decisions made behind the scenes it seems-staff pay.

Few staff who are backbitey and decease staff cooperation

Some students do not get the same quality of learning as others if they are not in the classrooms receiving rich vocabulary and rich conversation

Some conversations have gotten out to other people. This makes me not feel safe discussing concerns.

More direction for paras

A more objective board- not friends, professional board members.

A superintendent should be hired as part time position so the principal can focus on his/her full time position supporting our staff and most importantly our students. A full time counselor (not having other duties during the day) and/or social worker is needed with the departure of Mrs. Murphy. Para support placement should be based on student data and student needs to effectively support the students in their assigned classrooms. It would be nice to have more steps and lanes on the pay scale for staff who want to continue receiving PD opportunities (college credits) without acquiring another degree. An instructional coach position should be a high priority to support staff and students even if the grant is not renewed.

Things I would change about the school is the amount of favoritism that is shown, have paraprofessional placement done by looking at the data (not revolving around recess duties) I believe it should be scheduled by someone who knows how to teach reading, interventions, and data usage, be more transparent about money/funds, hold custodians responsible for their duties (cleaning, fixing, etc.), be more intent on following up to ensure that action plans get followed through, stronger and more consistent communication, more regular staff meetings so we can have professional development, prioritize administration attendance and participation in meetings, and hold high expectations across the board; for all staff (including classified) and students: integrity of being safe, respectful, responsible, and PAWS*titve.

No afterschool for kindercubs and kindergarteners,

Do not re-apply for the Literacy Grant if there is a choice. Treat all staff both certified and classified with respect. There currently is staff who treat some of our classified staff disrespectfully. Hold staff accountable for their behavior. If there is disagreement with our Principal, there still needs to be a level of respect. It is ok to disagree but not ok to bad mouth and gossip. When board members are elected their behavior needs to be professional and not attacking to staff and other board members, including bringing their spouse to attack staff and other board members. I think there just needs to be more respect for all positions at Boulder Elementary - Classified, Certified, Administration and Board members. We have staff who work
