Practice At Home

Spelling: Dipthongs (oy, oi, ow, ou)

OY and OW are used to spell their sounds at the end of words. OW can be followed by 'l', 'n', or 'er'.

OI and OU are used to spell their sounds in the beginning or middle of words.

Reading: We will begin learning about what a paleontologist does by reading stories about famous paleontologists and their historical discoveries.

Math: We will continue learn and practice different strategies to add two-digit numbers.
