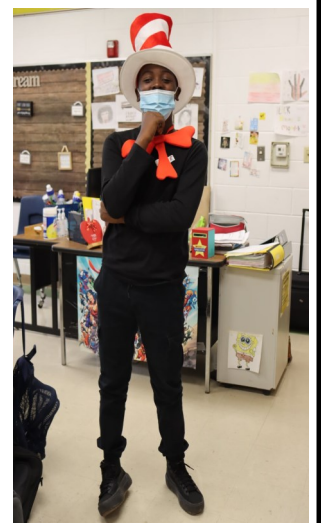
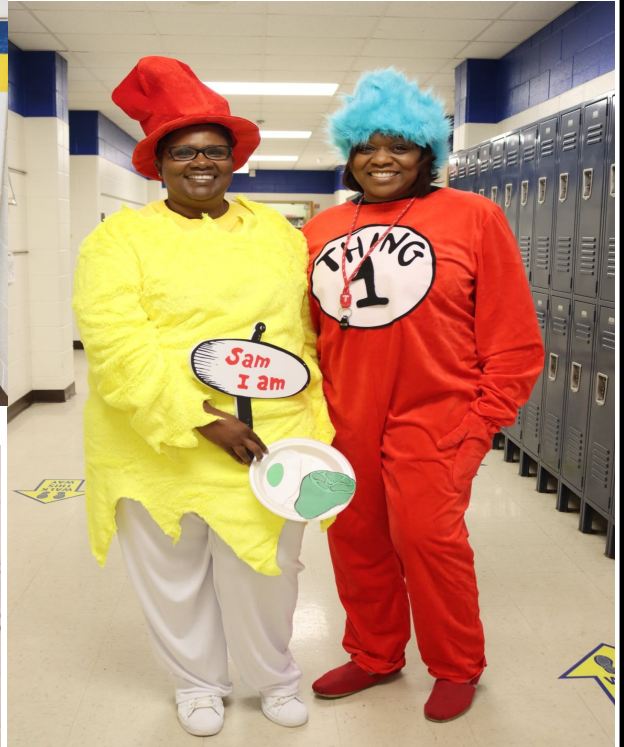
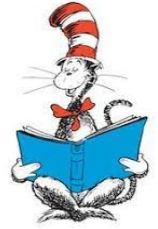
Science at the Farm

Clay County Elementary School had a unique opportunity to experience hands-on STEM activities on Jimmy Carter's Boyhood Farm on March 4th. Third-Fifth Grade students traveled to Plains, Ga for the Georgia Youth Science & Technology Center sponsored event that was designed to empower students for STEM careers. Students learned how solar power, the water cycle, life cycle, and pollinators impact their lives on a daily basis. Students met individuals who currently have a STEM career as well as students from Georgia Southwestern University who are pursuing the education needed to obtain a STEM career in the future. CCES students also participated in creating a worm farm, completing a fossil dig, examining owl pellets and creating UV bracelets.

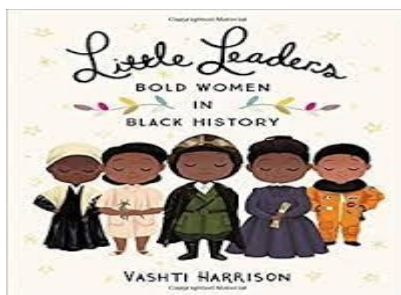
