- Students will be rewarded for Honor Roll, Perfect Attendance, and Good Behavior. Rewards may include a pizza party or free time.
- Students receiving behavior interventions will meet at least monthly with an administrator to discuss current behavior and strategies to use in the classroom.

# Critical Initiatives

- progress. Contact may be via email, phone, or Zoom sessions.
