Itawamba County School District will offer the TRADITIONAL classroom setting for the 2023-24 school year. ICSD will follow guidance from the Mississippi Department of Health and mandates from the governor.
Hand sanitizers will be available in every classroom
*Itawamba County School District may elect to offer limited durations of virtual instruction in the case of an emergency or high volume of sick students.
*School visitors may be limited per recommendation of the MS Dept. of Health



Hand sanitizer will be available on every bus.
Students and bus drivers may wear masks or face coverings that follow the dress code while inside the bus.



All cafeterias will be open and fully functional.
*Covered or individually wrapped food items will be available when feasible.
Hand sanitization stations will be available at each serving line.



Masks, face shields, and face coverings will be optional.



Itawamba County School District will follow all Mississippi High School Activities Association (MHSAA) guidelines as it pertains to athletics events and activities.
*Per MHSAA, virtual learning students may not participate in athletics or activities.



Quarantine Procedures:

*Students and staff who have a positive COVID-19 test result will quarantine until they are fever-free for 24 hours prior to returning to school.
*Students and staff will be required to bring a doctor's note for absences to be excused.
*Students/staff who are close contacts WILL NOT be required to quarantine unless they develop symptoms and receive a positive test result.
