Practice At Home

- UFLI at home practice will guide you through the spelling pattern we are learning in class. Practice, practice, practice! These spelling patterns come and go quickly!
- ❖ Read 20 minutes each night and document it on your October reading log. These will be due at the end of the month.
- ❖ Math Practice sheets will reflect what we have been learning in class so that you can do a little more at home.

This Week's Agenda

Spelling: the long /o/ sound with oa, ow, and oe **Oa**: is at the beginning or in the middle of a word

Ow: is used at the end of a syllable. It can go in the beginning or middle of a syllable if it is followed by 'l' or 'n'

Oe: is used at the end of words, but it is an uncommon spelling Reading: We will continue to read and write about different schools around the world. This week we are reading about monsoon season in Bangladesh, and how schools stay up and running regardless of the weather. We are working to write notes to structure and write a paragraph about the problem and solution these schools face. Math: We will begin learning strategies to add two-digit numbers
