

February 17, 2026 Regular Meeting

The Unified Board of Trustees met in regular session on Tuesday, February 17, 2026 in the High School Library. Chairman, Harold Erlenbusch called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

PRESENT

Members present were: Chairman, Harold Erlenbusch, Beth Murnion, Amber Saylor, Wyatt Colvin, and Jason Nordlund. Also present were: Principal, Judy Billing; Clerk, Anna Guesanburu; and Beth Lawrence.

AGENDA

Motion was made by Saylor, seconded by Colvin to approve the agenda without correction. Motion carried unanimously.

A.D. REPORT

Athletic Director, Beth Lawrence informed the Board she may have someone interested in being the golf coach. The 2026-27 basketball schedule is already in the planning and there may need to be a few Thursday night football games next season due to ref shortages around the State.

PRINCIPAL REPORT

Principal, Judy Billing informed the Board she received an application today for the history position. Mrs. Billing will set up an interview with the applicant. The Board agreed Trustee Saylor and Murnion will hand out diplomas at graduation this year.

MINUTES

Motion was made by Saylor, seconded by Murnion to approve the minutes of the January 20, 2026 regular meeting without correction or addition. Motion carried unanimously.

CONSENT AGENDA

Motion was made by Murnion, seconded by Nordlund to approve the consent agenda including the following items: #6.1 Accounts Payable/Payroll Claims; #6.2 Payroll Claims Transfers; and #6.3 Extra-curricular reports HS/EL. SUPERINTENDENT CONTRACT

Chairman Erlenbusch recommended to the Board at this time Superintendent's salary be put on hold. Motion was made by Nordlund, seconded by Murnion to approve Chairman Erlenbusch recommendation of Superintendent's salary to be put on hold. Motion carried unanimously.

PLUMBING ISSUES

Principal Billing informed the Board Bobby Davidson had been to the elementary to look at the plumbing issues. Mr. Davidson is going to give the school an estimate on what it will cost to fix the plumbing.

ADVERTISEMENT OPTIONS

Principal Billing informed the Board she had received information from New Media Broadcasters about airing commercials for advertising open positions for schools. The Board agreed the price was too high for that type of publicity.

26-27 HEALTH INSURANCE

Clerk Guesanburu informed the Board at the end of the fiscal year our health insurance provider, MUST, will be dissolving. After receiving some information and quotes from our health insurance rep, Tamara Crower, the Board and the JEA agreed Joint Powers Trust (JPT) would be a good option. Motion was made by Nordlund, seconded by Colvin to approve Joint Powers Trust as the District's 2026-27 health insurance provider. Motion carried unanimously.
