Award Amount

- A \$1000 one-time award made payable at the beginning of the second term/semester. Conditions apply (see below #5 in application section).

Application timing

- January 15th - February 28th
- Winners will be notified during the awards ceremony.

Requirements

- Eligibility – Clark High School seniors seeking an on-campus degree program related to the fields in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math), Education, or in the building trades (Plumbing, Electrical, Lineman, HVAC, Construction, etc.)
- Minimum high school GPA 2.50 with no failing courses.
- Attendance at any 2/4 Year South Dakota Universities, Colleges, or Vocational Institutes.
- Must attend a program requiring multi sessions/semesters
- Must enroll and start taking courses in the same year that scholarship is awarded.

- Must NOT use AI tools to complete essay questions (Chat GPT, CoPilot, GROK, etc).
Applicants will be disqualified if it is determined that AI was used.

A complete application package should contain each of the following:

1. Completed application
2. Certified transcript for all high school sessions completed
3. Four essay responses (typed)
4. Letter of recommendation (typed) from someone in the community, church, an adult friend, or mentor. **cannot be from a parent or relative
5. Letter of recommendation from a school employee. This recommendation must highlight, at minimum, the following attributes:
 - Leadership skills
 - Work ethic
 - Behavior
 - Your respect for teachers, administration, and fellow students.
