INDEPENDENT STUDY TEACHER

JOB GOAL/PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

Understands the independent study policies and procedures, including recordkeeping, forms, work samples, contracts, and report cards.

Assume responsibility for the safety and welfare of pupils.

Develop and maintain professional relationships with school and staff where program is located.

Plans a program of studies, including homework designed to meet the individual needs, interests, and abilities of the students.

Guides the learning process, using clear objectives, while achieving curriculum goals. Objectives, units and projects will be consistent with the curriculum goals communicated to students.

Assesses the accomplishments of students on a regular basis and provides progress reports as required.

Creates and maintains a classroom environment conducive to learning appropriate to the identified needs of the student.

Maintains accurate and complete records as required by law, District policy and administrative regulations.

Cooperates with other members of the school or District staff in planning instructional goals, objectives, methods and curriculum.

Assists in the selection of books, equipment and other instructional materials.

Establishes and maintains cooperative relations with others.

Works to establish and maintain open lines of communication with students and their parents concerning both the academic and behavioral progress of assigned students.
