EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT FOR CHIEF SCHOOL FINANCIAL OFFICER

This contract is made and entered into as of the <u>1st</u> day of <u>August</u>, 2021, between the Sumter County Board of Education (hereinafter referred to as the "Board of Education" and "Board") and Jackie Meeks (hereinafter referred to as the "Chief School Financial Officer" and "CSFO").

WHEREAS, the Board of Education, at a meeting held on the <u>5th</u> day of October, approved an employment contract of the Chief School Financial Officer in accordance with the terms and conditions of this contract; and

WHEREAS, the Chief School Financial Officer desires to be employed by the Board of Education in accordance with the terms of this modified contract; and

WHEREAS, the signature of the Board President has been duly authorized by a majority vote by the Board of Education taken at its meeting held on October 5th 2021

NOW THEREFORE, for the consideration and the mutual covenants and promises hereinafter contained, it is agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:

- 1. <u>EMPLOYMENT:</u> The Board of Education hereby employs Jackie Meeks as the Chief School Financial Officer and Jackie Meeks hereby enters into the employ of the Board of Education as Chief School Financial Officer of the School District. Such employment shall be subject to the terms and conditions of this contract.
- 2. **DUTIES:** The Chief School Financial Officer shall serve as the overseer of all school funds for the entire school district. The Chief School Financial Officer shall be responsible for all school funds in accordance with the Alabama Code, the Alabama Department of Education rules and regulations, and Board of Education policy, so long as said rules and regulations and policies are not in conflict with the applicable provisions of the Alabama Code. Further, the Chief School Financial Officer shall also assist in organizing and coordinating all matters related to the finances and fiscal operations of the Board, in cooperation with the Board's Superintendent of Education (hereinafter referred to as "Superintendent") and/or designee. The Chief School Financial Officer shall work

under the direct supervision of the Superintendent but shall have a fiduciary responsibility to the Board of Education as set f011h in §16-13A-5 of the Code of Alabama.

3. TERMS:

- (a) <u>Term:</u> This contract shall take effect as the 1^{st} day of <u>August</u>, 2021 and continue thereafter through the 1^{st} day of <u>August</u>, 2023 subject however, to termination, non-renewal and/or extension as hereafter provided.
- (b) <u>Discharge and Termination:</u> The Chief School Financial Officer may be discharged and this contract terminated at any time for cause shown. For cause, for the purposes of the termination provisions of this contract, shall be defined as incompetence, insubordination, neglect of duty, immorality, failure to perform duties in a satisfactory manner, failure to report financial information accurately to the Board, or other good and just cause. These terms for termination shall be construed as defined by cases interpreting the Alabama teacher tenure law and/or the Students First Act of 2011.
- (c) <u>Unilateral Termination:</u> Except as specified in subdivision (2) of the subsection (b) of the Alabama Code §16-13A-4, the Board of Education, upon a majority of vote of its members, shall have unilateral authority to remove the Chief School Financial Officer.
- 4. <u>COMPENSATION:</u> The Board of Education shall pay to the Chief School Financial Officer, and the Chief School Financial Officer hereby agrees to accept from the Board of Education, in full payment of his services hereunder, compensation and other benefits as follows:
- (a) <u>Salary:</u> The Chief School Financial Officer shall be entitled to and shall receive an annual salary of <u>Seventy One Thousand Two hundred Ninety and 00/100</u> (\$71,290). The salary of the Chief School Financial Officer shall be paid in equal monthly installments in accordance with the policy of the Board of Education governing the same for its full-time employees or as otherwise agreed. It is understood, however, that any amendment to the Chief School Financial Officer's salary or other benefits shall not be deemed that the Board of Education has entered into a new agreement with the Chief School Financial Officer or has extended the term of this contract. However, it is expressly understood that the Chief School Financial Officer

contract will be considered for renewal based upon her performance as Chief School Financial Officer.

- (b) <u>Expenses</u>: The BOARD shall reimburse the CSFO for all reasonable and necessary expenses actually incurred by the CSFO while engaged in school business on behalf of the BOARD. Such payments shall be supported by itemized and verified vouchers and submitted for approval.
- Board sponsored and subsidized health (medical) insurance programs and other supplemental medical, dental, vision coverage to the same extent and on the same terms and conditions as such coverage made available to BOARD employees generally.
- (d). Retirement: The CSFO shall be eligible to participate in any other retirement, benefit, insurance, or other employee plans offered by the BOARD to its employees, and the CSFO shall be entitled to the same matching contribution or Board-provided benefits referable to such plans as are provided to other Board employees.
- (e) <u>Vacation</u>: The CSFO shall be entitle to received fifteen (15) days of paid vacation per contract year.
- (f) <u>Leave</u>: The CSFO shall be entitled to receive such personal leave, sick leave, other types of leave, and paid holidays as are provided to full-time, twelve-month certificated Board employees, and to extent not expressly provided for herein, to receive such benefits are generally accorded certificated employees of the Board.
- (g) <u>Professional Development:</u> The CSFO shall be allowed to attend, at BOARD expense, statewide professional development meetings and conferences for CSFOs and at least one national conference per year, if so requested by the CSFO. The BOARD shall pay directly or shall reimburse the CSFO for reasonable travel, lodging, and meal expenses, and for conference, seminar, or meeting registration fees, if any, incurred by the CSFO (but not any family member or guest of the CSFO) attending these meetings, conferences, or seminars. Such reimbursement shall be supported by appropriate documentation. The BOARD shall pay any cost incurred by the CSFO in maintaining such licensure as may be required by the BOARD as a condition of the CSFO's employment. The BOARD shall pay dues required for the CSFO's membership in the following professional associations:

^{1.} Alabama Association of School Business Officials (AASBO);

^{2.} Council for Leaders in Alabama Schools (CLAS)

^{3.} Alabama Association of School Personnel Administrators (AASPA)

- 5. **EVALUATION:** The Chief School Financial Officer shall be evaluated annually by the Board of Education. The Chief School Financial Officer agrees to participate in the evaluation process and agrees to use her best efforts to perform faithfully the duties of the Chief School Financial Officer as outlined in §16-1 3A-5 of the Code of Alabama, otherwise assigned, and as set forth in this contract. The Chief School Financial Officer agrees to abide by the rules, regulations and policies promulgated by the Board of Education before or during the term of this contract. Any omission or failure of the Board to ensure the Chief School Financial Officer is evaluated shall not result in any extension of this contract and shall not constitute a new contract.
- 6. **DUTY TO REPORT:** It is expressly agreed by and between the parties hereto that the Chief School Financial Officer reports directly to the Superintendent but shall have a fiduciary responsibility to the Board of Education as contemplated by the Code of Alabama §16-13A-5 and further, except as specified in subdivision (2) of subsection (b) of §16-13A-4, the Board of Education, upon a majority vote of its members, shall have unilateral authority to remove the Chief School Financial Officer.
- 7. (a) Tenure or Non-probationary Status Not Applicable: Chief School Financial Officer acknowledges that she is not eligible for tenure and/or non-probationary status as the Chief School Financial Officer pursuant to the Students First Act. Moreover, neither this contract, nor other matters regarding the Chief School Financial Officer's employment, shall be deemed to confer tenure or non-probationary status on the Chief School Financial Officer, whether expressed or implied. The Chief School Financial Officer's rights and term of employmentare limited to those as set folih in this contract, or any extension hereof.
- (b) Return to Position: The parties acknowledge that the Chief School Financial Officer was previously tenured as and served in the position of Accountant with the Board of Education prior to accepting the position of Chief School Financial Officer. Should this Contract be permitted to expire or be terminated as set forth herein, and unless the Board of Education concurrently acts to terminate or modify the terms and conditions of the Chief School Financial Officer's employment with respect to her non-CSFO employment, the Chief School Financial Officer shall be entitled to return to a position with the Board's school system comparable to the classified twelve month position which she last held and with such tenure or nonprobationary status as may have been earned in the previously held classified position before appointment as Chief School Financial Officer. The salary for such position shall not be lower than the salary last earned by the Chief School Financial Officer as a Staff Accountant employed by the Board of Education prior to accepting the position of Chief School Financial Officer, but subject to any salary adjustments by any legislative and step increases that would have been applied to such salary for the previously held celiified position during the time period when the Chief School

Financial Officer was serving as Chief School Financial Officer. However, nothing herein shall be construed to prohibit the Board of Education from terminating or modifying the Chief School Financial Officer's employment in any non-CSFO capacity at any time to the extent and in the manner otherwise permitted by law.

8. **MISCELLANEOUS:**

- (a) Governing Law: This contract has been executed in the State of Alabama and shall be govelned in accordance with the laws of the State of Alabama in every respect and other applicable laws, rules and regulations. This contract is further subject to the Board of Education's policies, rules and regulations as now or hereafter adopted.
- (b) <u>Headings:</u> Paragraph headings and numbers have been inserted for convenience of reference only. If there shall be any conflict between any such headings or numbers and the text of this contract, the text shall control.
- (c) <u>Exclusive Terms:</u> This contract contains all of the terms agreed upon by the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior agreements, arrangements and communications between the parties concerning such subject matter whether oral or written, including, but not limited to, any prior contract.
- (d) <u>Severability:</u> The provisions of this contract shall be deemed severable, and the invalidity of any portion hereof shall not affect the validity of the remainder thereof.
- (e) <u>Non-renewal:</u> In the event the Board of Education should elect to not renew the contract of the Chief School Financial Officer, then the Board of Education shall provide her with a minimum of one hundred twenty (120) days' notice prior to the end of said contract. In the event the Board of Education should not give notice of its election not to renew this contract as required herein, then the term of the contract shall be extended for a period of one year.
- (f) <u>Extension:</u> It is expressly understood and agreed that this contract may be extended only by action of the Board of Education, by a majority vote thereof, provided the Chief School Financial Officer accepts said extension and the terms thereof, except as set forth in section (e) above.
- 9. **BINDING EFFECT:** This contract shall be binding upon and inure to the benefits of the respective parties and their respective heirs, legal representatives, successors and assigns.
