- 1. A copy of **Acceptance Letter** from the college, university, or technical school/college you plan to attend.
- A short Essay summarizing your higher education aspirations and future career goals (preferably no longer than two pages). Your narrative should explain how your plans relate to the criteria for Feed Fannin's scholarship.
- 3. A list of the **school activities and clubs/student organizations** in which you have participated, leadership positions you held (i.e. FCYFA, 4-H, FFA, other), and scholastic awards and recognitions you received (i.e. Honor Roll, Principal's List, etc.).
- A list of community engagement activities (i.e. non-profit volunteer work), and any work experience (include employer(s) name(s) and job responsibilities).
- 5. At least one **letter of recommendation** from a teacher or school counselor. Additional letters of recommendation from other teachers, school administrators or non-family community leaders will also be welcomed.

# 2024 FEED FANNIN SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FOR GRADUATING SENIORS CRITERIA & INSTRUCTIONS

### **Background**

Feed Fannin is a non-profit, all-volunteer organization working to educate and encourage our community towards self-sufficiency while providing food for those in need in Fannin County and the Copper Basin. Feed Fannin scholarships are awarded to graduating seniors from Fannin County and Copper Basin High Schools to provide financial support to aspiring students entering higher education institutions. As an all-volunteer organization, Feed Fannin believes it is important to give back to the community by supporting students who have contributed through their volunteerism.

### **Qualification Criteria / Requirements – Applicants must:**

- Be accepted at a college, university, or technical school/college
- Have a minimum 3.0 grade point average during their senior year
- Plan to pursue degrees in agriculture, horticulture, environmental or food sciences or related fields.
  - While preference will be given to these studies, applicants who plan to pursue degrees in education may also be considered.
- Demonstrate active involvement in FFA, 4-H, Garden Club or in other activities, clubs and organizations at school or in the community related to the above fields of study.

### Application Process – Applicant must submit (see page 2 of application for more details):

- 1. Completed and signed application form. Please print clearly in black or blue ink.
- 2. Required attachments:
  - a. Essay summarizing higher education aspirations and future career goals
  - b. List of school and community activities and organizations in which you have participated during the past 4 years while in high school (2 different lists)
  - **c.** Letters of recommendation from at least one teacher or school counselor. Letters from other teachers, school administrators or non-family community leaders are also welcomed.
  - d. All applications and required supporting documents must be received by APRIL 10, 2024.

#### **Scholarship Awards:**

Feed Fannin scholarships are cash awards in the total amount of \$1,000, paid in \$500 installments <u>for each semester</u>. Scholarship payments are made with the understanding that funds will be used for tuition, fees, books, or equipment needed to obtain a degree from the institution on the application.

Award checks will be sent to selected students promptly upon receipt of proof of enrollment by submitting their <u>semester class schedule</u> and <u>tuition receipt</u> from the educational institution. <u>School enrollment documents</u> should be sent within 30 days of enrollment for each semester. Checks will be sent only on receipt of the required supporting documentation. <u>Send digital or paper copies of supporting documents</u>, Attention Scholarship Committee, by email or USPS (see addresses below).
