- VI. **Approval of Minutes:** November 18 Mr. Rendon moved to approve the November 18 minutes as presented. Sr. Odilia Korenek seconded the motion. The November 18 minutes were approved as presented.
- VII. **Superintendent Items:**
 - a. Campus Reports – Student Progress & Teacher Expectations
 - i. Mrs. Garza noted that PVACC has 65 students enrolled, with another waiting on paperwork. There are 15 students enrolled in dual credit at Del Mar, with 12 of those in the 3-year continuing education program, which provides high school credit along with a certification and an Industry-Based Certification on their d when they graduate. We have 4 students in the hybrid program. ADA is around 95%. We have 1 student participating in Power Wash University, paid by the parent of a former student. When the student graduates, they will receive a power washer to allow them to start a business of their own. We have a recruitment appointment to talk to the ML Garza Middle School students about attending PVA when they graduate from junior high. We are in discussions with the Big Brother/Big Sister program for some of our students to become mentors to ML Garza students.

- ii. Mrs. Frankowiak noted that PVA has 110 students with more students enrolling daily. She discussed some possible grant opportunities that are opening up in the near future. December STARR testing went well. US History was at 100% while English was at 54%, Science was at 85%, and Algebra was 45%. Attendance has been good. We have been trying to figure out why enrollment has been low, but it seems as if all schools are having the same issue.
- b. Audit – Ms. Jones presented the 2024-2025 audit to the board and noted that there were no findings in the audit. A single audit was not required this year. Mr. Rendon moved to approve the 2024-2025 audit as presented. Mrs. Koenning seconded the motion. The 2024-2025 audit was approved.
