PASTOR'S COLUMN

Dear Parishioners of St. Therese,

This week is a very special week in the Easter season. Beginning this Monday, all of this week's Gospels will be from the *Bread of Life* discourse in **Chapter 6 of John's Gospel**. These readings will then culminate with the **First Communion of our Parish and School children on Sunday, April 21st (at both the 9:00 and 11:00 a.m. Masses)**. Here is our moment to bring about a Eucharistic Revival within our hearts and minds as individual believers, as families, and as a Parish! I would ask all of you to pray and intercede for our First Communicants, that they may be enkindled with a fire of love for Our Lord present in the Holy Eucharist.

Below are two patron saints of First Communicants whom we can invoke to intercede for our beloved children. Thank you for your support!

St. Tarsicius of Rome, a martyr of the Blessed Sacrament from third-century Rome, became the first Patron Saint of First Communicants. After Mass, he took consecrated Hosts to imprisoned Christians awaiting martyrdom. As a boy, he would be less suspect making the visit than if he were a man. As he traveled to the prison along the Roman road, known as the Appian Way, he ran into a group of pagan boys and men who began to harass him. While they did not know, specifically, that he belonged to the hidden group of Christians, they demanded he show them what he had in his hands, which were hiding in his clothes. Tarsicius refused, knowing they would likely take and desecrate the Blessed Sacrament if they got it from him.

His continued refusal angered the crowd, who began to assault him. As the angry mob beat him, Tarsicius fell to the stones of the Appian Way, shielding the Host beneath his body. The mob continued their attack even after he fell, eventually killing him. When they rolled his body over to discover what he had been hiding, they found nothing. The Host had vanished.

St. Tarsicius and Bl. Imelda, pray that next Sunday's First Communicants will be enkindled with a fire of love for Our Lord in the Eucharist!

Blessed Imelda Lambertini had an all consuming desire for unity with Jesus in Holy Communion. Born to a noble family in Bologna, Italy, in 1322, from as young as five years of age, she expressed a deep desire to receive Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament by making her First Communion. At that time, the age to receive was set around 14, so Imelda found her greatest desire denied her. This disappointment did not diminish her desire to live in God's grace and she persisted in seeking permission to receive Holy Communion.

At age nine she went to live with the Dominican nuns at Val di Pietra, a neighboring monastery. She fervently hoped the chaplain for the convent would allow her to receive Holy Communion, since she was living as a nun, but he held firm that she must wait.

At the age of eleven, she was seen by one of the sisters, kneeling as she had been when they left, with a glowing light suspended above her. Inside that light was the Sacred Host. The other sisters were called, as was the chaplain. Seeing the scene, he knew that his decision was overruled and that Jesus was making His desire known. The chaplain gave Imelda her first Holy Communion. Kneeling in prayer and ecstasy, the child closed her eyes and joined her Lord as her soul departed from her body. She went from First Communion to Eternal Communion.

"LET ME INTRODUCE YOU..." By Fr. Stephen F. Watson, OCD

"Pastors must regard as one of their primary pastoral duties the faithful visitation of families to bring the message of Christ's peace. They will thus obey the command of Christ to His disciples: 'On entering any house, first say: 'Peace to this house' (Luke 10:5). Pastors and their assistants must, therefore, consider as a sacred trust the custom of an annual visit, particularly during the Easter season, to the families living in their parishes."



The above words from the Book of Blessings—regarding the annual blessing of families in their own homes—were on my mind as I made a visit to the **Omar and Adriana Guijarro Valle Family** in Boyle Heights during the octave of Easter. Boyle Heights, of course, is not within St. Therese Parish boundaries, and—as a former pastor myself—I didn't want to be accused of "poaching." However, I went there for supper and used the occasion to impart an Easter blessing. (It's like the Jesuit joke: "Father, can I smoke a cigarette while I'm praying?" "No, but you can pray while you are

smoking.") Boyle Heights is one of Los Angeles' most notable and historic Mexican-American communities. So, how is it that this family is so involved in St. Therese Parish? This is their story.

Omar and Adriana were born in Zacatecas, Mexico, and were raised in Catholic homes. However, as young adults they both began to drift from the practice of the Faith. Omar was in a band when he and Adriana first met at a rock concert. In 2002, they were civilly married. At that time, Adriana's mother was living in Los Angeles, so Adriana and Omar decided to move there in 2006. They already had their first born, Uriel, who is now twenty-one. Since coming to L.A., three more children were added to the family: Joanna, 17, Ethan, 9, and Karla, 6. Uriel is about to graduate from Cal State LA with a degree in Computer Information Systems. The other three children do their schooling online at local public schools: East College Prep for Joanna and Second Street Elementary for Ethan and Karla. Availing themselves of occupational training schools, Omar is now a journeyman electrician, while Adriana is a licensed cosmetologist and esthetician.

When Adriana was unable to be a confirmation sponsor for one of her nephews because she wasn't married in the Church, she felt bad about the situation and thus began preparing to have her marriage blessed in the Church. In 2017, she and Omar were married at Resurrection Church in Boyle Heights. Thus began a deepening of their Catholic faith. Then, Adriana learned about the Latin Mass at St. Therese and felt drawn to experience it. She was so moved at the reverence that the family began attending it regularly—at first a couple Sundays a month and then every Sunday. As her faith deepened, Adriana decided to put her career to the side to raise their children in the Faith. The family decided to become parishioners at St. Therese just before Covid hit. The warm spirits of Fr. Godfrey, Fr. David, and Fr. Bernard helped them feel welcomed. Fr. Thomas, who was the Pastor when they began attending, led them in their consecration to Jesus through Mary. This deepened their faith and the family has really given itself to the Lord ever since. Fr. Thomas also helped with and supported the creation of the Spanish Prayer Ministry at our church. Last May, this ministry hosted a Pentecost retreat. Out of her desire to make the Adoration Chapel nice for the Lord, Adriana also began cleaning the chapel and creating flower arrangements for it.

Later, Adriana became acquainted with Florence Goh, the head of our Religious Education Program. So now, she and her daughter, Joanna, are teaching catechism here at St. Therese. Adriana, Omar, and Uriel are also serving as Lectors. Uriel also programs the key cards for access to the Adoration Chapel and volunteers to set up the technology for the teachers in Religious Education. As a family, they have helped to serve the St. Therese Community through events such as our movie nights and by creating flower arrangements for special church events. Omar was a tremendous help in hanging the centennial banners that adorn the façade of the church.

This past March, Omar and Adriana attended a seminar about promoting vocations at the parish level. Now, in their own household, their two oldest children are discerning their vocations to religious life, while Ethan is looking to serve as an altar server, and Karla talks about becoming a Sister and having the family live in her monastery (ha, ha!). It is certainly true that the family that prays together stays together. The Guijarro Valle family, who are very close-knit in faith, are most welcome in St. Therese Parish!

The Guijarro Valle Family is part of the rich 100-year history of St. Therese Parish.
Let us all walk with St. Therese as we journey together in faith during this centennial year.
