Old business discussed – tax abatement request. Volk moved, seconded by Egge, to approve the tax abatement resolution and application. Voting in favor: Egge, Fest, Hendel, Rasche, Volk. Abstaining from vote: Janssen. Motion carried.

Fest moved, seconded by Egge to declare as surplus mini-bus 9 and Bus 4. The motion carried.

Egge moved, seconded by Fest to approve Pay Equity Implementation Report. The motion carried.

Fest moved, seconded by Egge to approve FCCLA fundraiser – Taste of the World. The motion carried.

Egge moved, seconded by Hendel to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried.
