

The Benton County R-2 School District board members continued the meeting in executive session after a short break on June 20, 2022 beginning at 8:24P.M. Board members present were Yearout, Parrott, Sanders, Eichler, Koll, and Smallwood. Rutherford was absent.

Kevin Smith, Becky Eifert, and Michelle Smith were also present. Adam Curtis was absent.

Mr. Smith shared a letter of resignation from Chris Sanders for Head Softball Coach. A motion made by Parrott, seconded by Eichler to accept the resignation from Chris Sanders for Head Softball Coach. Motion carries as follows: Smallwood- yes; Koll-yes; Eichler-yes; Sanders-abstained; Rutherford-absent; Parrott-yes; and Yearout-yes; Motion carried 5 ayes 0 no, 1 abstained.

Mr. Smith shared a letter of resignation from Nolan Wilson for JH Social Studies for the 2022-2023 school year. Mr. Wilson still owes food service \$107.10 from the 2019/2020 school year. Once Mr. Wilson pays the debt owed, he will be released from the Probationary Contract signed March 25, 2022.
