

#### Tech info for SENIORS

#### Seniors & Your Devices

Seniors, as you graduate from SLHS, you get to keep your school device! There is **No Fee** for keeping your tablet. If you choose not to keep yours, the device needs to be returned to the technology department.

If you are keeping your device, the Technology Department <u>will need</u> to recondition (remove from Saxony domain, create new admin and standard users) the device and lease ownership.

#### SENIORS: bring your device to TECH between May 8—10.

\*\*You must be finished will all Saxony class coursework before bringing in your device to Tech.\*\*

If not brought in before Mandatory Graduation practice, we will ask for your device that day.

BEFORE you turn in tablet, GET ALL YOUR FILES YOU WANT TO KEEP AND BACK THEM UP ON A DIFFERENT SOURCE (OneDrive, USB drive, external HDD, etc.) Turnaround time from drop off to available for pick up, will vary. All will be completed by grad practice May 10.

Need help with saving files or have questions? Ask Technology Department for assistance.

A suggestion is to drop off your device to Tech before graduation practice and by the time its over, the device should be done – as long as you have any data you want to keep already backed up off your device.

After graduation, Saxony and the Technology Department are no longer obligated to maintain, fix, reformat, or recondition your device.

#### Seniors and their parents & PlusPortals Accounts

Seniors and their parents will have access to PlusPortals accounts until July 1, 2024.

#### Seniors & Microsoft 365 (including OneDrive) Accounts

Senior's Microsoft 365 Saxony account services of email, Teams, OneNote, Office Web Apps, and OneDrive storage assess will be active **until August 1, 2024.** On that date, those M365 services will be removed from our system and only M365 Office programs (Word, PowerPoint, Excel, OneNote, Access, and Publisher) on your device will work using your Saxony account.

#### **From the Technology Department:**

#### **SENIORS & Library Books**

If you have a Saxony library book, those need to be returned by the end of school on May 12. Fines will be applied to student accounts on that date for non-returned books.

#### Tech info for JUNIORS, SOPHOMORES, & FRESHMEN

#### **Device Return**

The last day of school, May 16 after students' last final exam, teachers will collect all student devices and accessories that were issued to them in August at the beginning of school AND **any loaned chargers, devices, or stylus** from the Tech Department. Students, if you have a loaner charger or stylus, start looking for it now! You may return the item to the Tech Department at any time, but we do hope you have it for return by May 16.

If a student is **taking a summer school course**, to keep their device for the duration of that course, Mrs. Kiehne, school counselor, must be notified and those students MUST complete device checkout with the Tech Department on May 16.

#### Required items to be returned: AC adapter, protective case, provided stylus, and device

If a student does not return a required item or item is not functional, the following replacement fines will be assigned to student's account with the financial office:

#### Student device item replacement fees:

Missing or broken (not due to electricity or defect) charger = \$20

Missing protective case = \$30

**Stylus = \$37** 

Any wireless mouse dongles, papers, pictures, etc, must be *removed* before you turn it in. Per the Student Technology Acceptable Use Policy found in the Student Handbook:

"No Stickers, adhesive decoration or direct application materials are allowed to the device and case (Fines may apply for their removal)"

Saving Files from Tablet: If students want to keep any files saved to the device or passwords in your web browser, they MUST be saved to OneDrive, a USB drive, external HDD, etc. BEFORE device turn-in. THE FILES WILL BE DELETED DURING DEVICE REFRESH OVER THE SUMMER.

Need help with this? Ask Technology Department for assistance.

#### <u>Iuniors, Sophomores, Freshmen and parents & PlusPortals</u>

Student and Parent PlusPortals accounts will have the 23-24 school year information **until July 1**, when we switch over to the next school year. A report card will be available for printing from PlusPortals for the 23-24 school year after the rollover. Log into PlusPortals, click the More... Button, click School, and then click Report Card.

#### <u>Iuniors, Sophomores, Freshmen & Office365 (including OneDrive) Accounts</u>

Students will continue to **HAVE ACCESS** to their school email and OneDrive accounts through the summer – nothing will change for these accounts.

Students and Staff: Email notifications and daily morning announcements for library materials checked out will be made the first week of May. If you have a Saxony library book, **please return borrowed book(s)** to the Tech Department **by the end of school, May 16.** Fines will be sent to the financial office on that date for non-returned books.
