Superintendent Shinall reported on his board report. The Board was briefed on the application for the School Maintenance Grant. He mentioned that we are in compliance with IDEA. He publicly thanked Lonna Sumner, Julie Albritton, and Billy Robison. We will be able to test for COVID-19 on campus and it is completely optional as in-person instruction is the goal.

Mr. Robison reported on his High School Report. He shared an update on professional development and mentioned how Dr. Pam Rosa will be assisting throughout the year. The American Rescue Plan – ESSER III. Superintendent Shinall mentioned that this grant must cover costs associated with (but not limited to) summer school, learning loss, after-school program(s), as well as general budget items. More detail can be found on the District's website, where the plan has been posted, per ISBE requirement. Meyer questioned the allotment; Shinall mentioned just over \$444k.

Superintendent Shinall explained the need for the \$500,000 increase in coverage and that it was our Auditor's recommendation. He also thanked Kyle and Michele for the audit going well.
