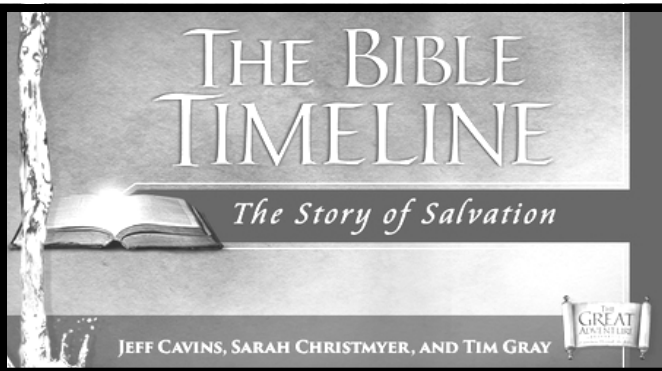
## Catholicism's Pivotal Players

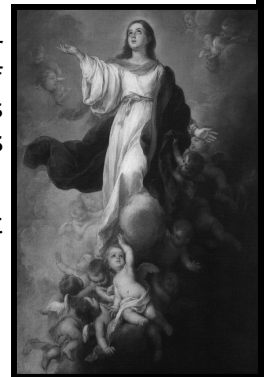
## FEAST OF THE ASSUMPTION

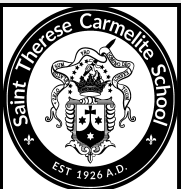

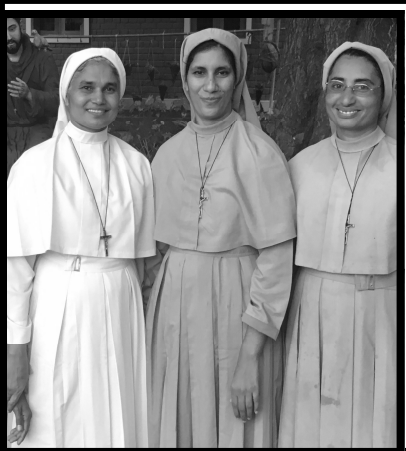

# MISSIONARY APPEAL

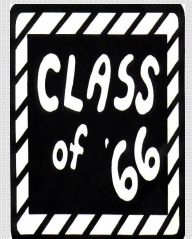
