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STUDENT DRIVING AND PARKING REGULATIONS			
Only members of the Senior and Junior classes are permitted to drive to school.			
All student vehicles must be registered with the school and display the current parking permit;			
Exercise safe driving practices, remembering that pedestrians have the right of way.			
Park only in designated student parking lots.			
Student parking lots will be entered via the <u>UPPER</u> parking lot entrance.			
When arriving or departing the parking lots, students must follow the one-way direction of traffic;			
Park in one space only <u>BETWEEN THE LINES</u> . Always remember that pedestrians have the <u>RIGHT OF WAY</u> .			
After parking, students must leave the parking lots <u>NO LOITERING</u>			
Must arrive dressed in the appropriate school uniform.			
Upon arriving at school, students that drive cannot depart without permission.			
The school is not responsible for the vehicle or its contents.			
The owner of the vehicle is responsible for maintaining auto insurance as required by state law.			
In the event of an accident on campus, the owners are responsible for calling the police and obtaining an accident report;			
Student vehicles are subject to search if there is a reasonable ground to believe drugs, alcohol, weapons, stolen property or			
other contraband might be present in the vehicle.			
No smoking on campus includes inside of vehicles.			
Any student that withdraws from school must return their parking permit as part of the check-out process for withdrawal;			
<u>SENIORS</u> are required to tum in their parking permit as part of the check-out process for graduation. Parking regulations will be strictly enforced.			
<u>REPLACEMENT</u> of loss or stolen parking permits will be at a cost of \$45.00;			
Parking tags are \$75.00 and nontransferable.			
They are to be used for the vehicle registered <u>ONLY</u> .			
The following actions will result in the immediate loss of driving privileges disciplinary actions and/or suspension from school:			
Jumping curbs. Leaving campus without permission.			
Unauthorized use or falsification of a parking permit;			
Reckless operation of a motor vehicle.			
Giving, loaning, or selling a parking permit to another student;			
Non-compliance with any school official whose responsibility covers supervision of parking;			
Excessive absences or tardies to school.
