Sandy Acker, RN (head school nurse), gave the board a summary of the various duties the school nurses performed in school year 2009 – 2010. Mrs. Acker also gave the board a list of potential events planned for the 2010 – 2011 school year.

Moved, seconded, and carried to go into executive session to discuss or deliberate upon the appointment, employment, compensation, hiring, disciplinary action or dismissal, or periodic evaluation or rating of a public officer or employee; (O.C.G.A. 50-14-3(6)).

Moved, seconded, and carried to resume regular session.

Terry Bramlett, Chairman, announced no action was taken while in executive session.

Moved, seconded, and carried to approve Cecil Davis, Jr. to work at the cannery for the canning season.

Moved, seconded, and carried to amend the agenda and add Sales Ratio Appeal as agenda item number three and moved review agenda to item number four.

Superintendent Mark Henson shared results of the 2009 Sales Ratio Study with the board. Mr. Henson explained Fannin's ratio was 31.55 percent and the ratio should fall in the range of 36 & 44 percent. Mr. Henson explained on the advice of Lynn Doss, School Board Attorney, the board should appeal this ratio. Moved, seconded, and carried to appeal the 2009 Sales Ratio Study.
