Course Title: Clinical Internship Course Syllabus

This course is a one course credit designed for seniors to prepare for college and career readiness.

Clinical Internship students will meet safety guidelines and testing in areas of OSHA, CPR/First Aid, HIPAA, Blood Borne Pathogens, and Confidentiality as part of their classroom requirements before ever entering the rotations into the different selected facilities.

Students will also get a lifetime certification in OSHA 10 Healthcare- this is an industry certification. Another industry certification is CPR-BLS for healthcare providers that will expire in 2 years.

All students must maintain the guidelines of dress code, absenteeism, and facility rules in order to remain in the rotation. Each rotation will last approx 9 weeks and each student will have approximately 3 different sites throughout the year.

Clinical Internship is the capstone class for the Therapeutic Services Program of Study in the Health Science area. The following is a list of examples that the students will be required throughout the year to complete and collect in a portfolio that will be kept in the WBL classroom.

Portfolios may include:

- · Career and professional development plan- PLP
- · Resume
- \cdot Documentation of clinical hours at each site
- · List of responsibilities undertaken throughout the placement
- · Examples of materials developed and used throughout the placement
- · Periodic journal entries reflecting on tasks and activities
- · Supervisor evaluations and observations
- · Approved WBL forms
- \cdot WBL coordinator evaluations and observations

Assessments: Preceptor Evaluations, Clinical Log Sheets, Powerpoint presentations, OSHA 10 certification grade, CPR certification, written tests and skill demonstrations. Course standards can be found at tn.gov.
