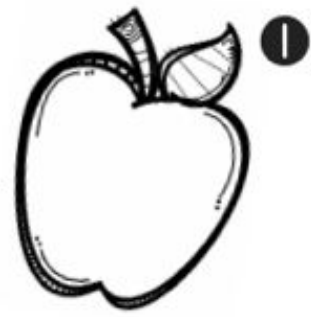

Back to School Blast

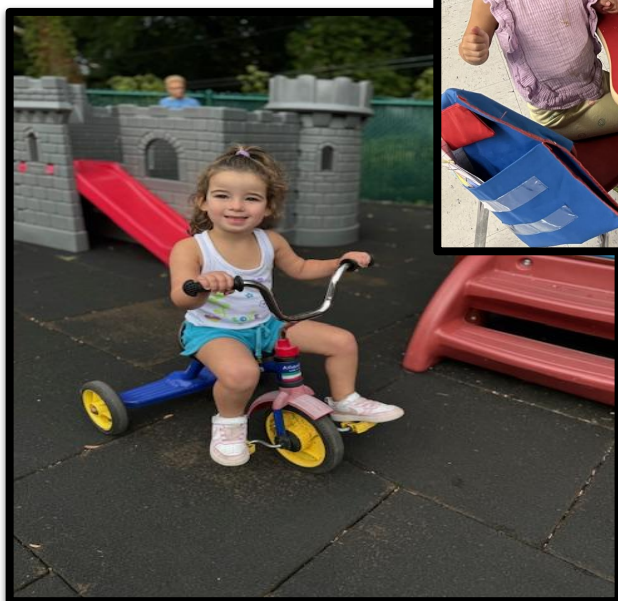
