


Notes from the Principal

Mandatory Volunteer Clearances

Dear St. Anne School Parents/Guardians:

As most parents are aware, the State of Pennsylvania and the Diocese of Allentown require that all volunteers in the school obtain Child Protection Clearances **prior** to participating in parent

<u>volunteer activities.</u> This includes **any** volunteer activity, parent sponsored event in the school and/or parish as well as coaching, field trip chaperones, classroom activities etc. Please contact me directly for clarification/information regarding volunteer activities.

- This is a matter of <u>PA STATE law and Diocesan regulation</u>, that St. Anne School is required to strictly follow and enforce.
- Information, directions, and forms can be found on the St. Anne School website.
 Please click on the "Parents" tab and then scroll to the "Volunteer Information tab."
- If you have any questions or concerns, if you wish to learn how to obtain all your clearances, or check the status of your current clearances – please DO NOT HESITATE to contact me at ebrida@stannebethlehem.org.
- PLEASE NOTE: Some clearances can take a few weeks to obtain, the sooner you acquire your clearances the better.
- If you currently have employee clearances through your place of work some of those
 may not be accepted for volunteer purposes per the State of PA. You will need new
 clearances. I can assist you with this process.
- I will do my best to make current volunteers aware of any upcoming expiring clearances.
- It is always a good idea that you keep a record of all your clearances. You should keep all your originals at home in a file and hand in only copies, so that you are aware of your own clearance status.
- If you wish to send in clearances, you can forward them to me via email or, you can hand them in through school (in an envelope To: Eileen Brida, marked "Clearances") or drop them at the school main office.
- I am pleased to assist you with this paperwork. Please contact me if you have <u>any</u> questions. I will respond as quickly as I can.




