



# From the desk of Mrs. Kiehne:

#### **Course Selection**

For next year is in full swing! For grades 9-11, we have been completing and reviewing four-year plans during Crusader Time. Parents, please ask to see your Crusader's plan and talk about it with them. In Crusader Time on March 18<sup>th</sup>, the students will select their courses electronically via their Plus Portals account. I am visiting Language Arts 1, 2, and 3 classes this week and next week to answer any specific questions students may still have. As a part of our selection process, I shared a video with the students to help them understand graduation requirements and specific choices they may need to make. I will share this video with parents in a separate email.

#### What do juniors need to know for course selection and senior year?

Each junior and their parents will meet with me individually for a "Junior Meeting." These meetings allow me to talk with students about their post-high school plans and assist individually with course selection. This helps to align students' course selections to post-high school plans. We also review the timeline of activities for senior year. If you have not signed up for your meeting, please do so at this link: <a href="https://www.signupgenius.com/go/10C0E4AABAB2FA0F4C07-55119187-junior">https://www.signupgenius.com/go/10C0E4AABAB2FA0F4C07-55119187-junior</a>. I have time available this week and on Saturday, March 8th. I will send a reminder email to students and parents this week with instructions for signing up.

#### What happens next?

After course selections are submitted, all selections are reviewed, and the administration determines which courses will be offered the following school year. Changes are made to course selections based on course sizes, student preparedness for courses, teacher recommendations, and other factors. Updated course selection reports are sent to students and families over the summer with the second semester report card. Please review these carefully. It is very difficult to make changes to selections after the end of May because over the summer, the school master schedule is created. Students receive their school schedules in early August.

#### What about the sophomore visit to CTC?

Sophomores visited the *Cape Girardeau or Perryville Career and Technology Centers* for a tour and information session in January. If your Crusader is planning to apply for a program for next year and has not, please turn in the application to me by <u>Thursday, March 6<sup>th</sup></u>. I have extra applications in the office if needed.

#### Finally, what about Seniors?

Seniors are busy making many plans and decisions regarding their plans for next year. It is easy to become anxious and overwhelmed. Please reach out to me if you have any questions. As a parent, if you have noticed some "senioritis," a bit of increased anxiety, and indecision, that is normal! 


