Dear Parishioners.

Welcome to Catholic Schools Week! Please look in the school portion for the various events planned for this week as we celebrate our St. Edward's School. As we do so, we thank God for the past – the students, faculty and staff, and parents – who have made our school what it is. We thank God for our present students, families and faculty and staff. But more importantly we pray for our School's future.

Our Catholic school is the largest ministry of our parish, one that not only forms the intellect of our students, but one that trains them in the faith. This is the essential difference between our Catholic school and our public school. Both provide excellent academics, both have great PE and sports, both have good food, but we can go beyond ethics and teach morality based on Divine Law, and we of course teach about Jesus Christ in a way that helps our students know Jesus as our Lord and Savior.

I am so thankful, therefore, for all who support our school both financially and in the sharing of time and talent. How blessed we are for the generosity of so many that help our school to thrive.

I have been notified again of a scammer texting people in my name asking for gift cards. Please ignore all requests that claim to be me. I would never ask for you to do anything of the sort. I am relatively certain that the criminals doing this are getting the numbers from the bulletin. In the last round, both I and Officer Bill contacted the person. In my contact, the person felt justified to impersonate me because they felt entitled to funds. That was telling to me – I KNOW that I am not entitled to ask for such 'favors' yet the scammer feels entitled to impersonate me to do so. There is no remorse. I enjoyed hearing of Officer Bill's communication – when he was asked to send a photo of the cards, he sent the person a picture of his badge. Then he offered to meet them in person. Of course, that closed down the conversations.

I pray for the conversion of the person(s) doing this. While it is not a violent crime, it does harm the good will of those swindled by it. I am contemplating what to do to address this. One option is to not publish phone numbers or emails, at least for a while. The easiest is for anyone who has either published in the bulletin or online to know that they will be subject to the scam and to ignore every attempt of the scammers.

Cost: Freewill offering retreat with non-refundable \$25 deposit to reserve your place.


