Sun. Nov. 22 - DEPART LOS ANGELES

Our journey begins as we depart Los Angeles on our flight to Tel Aviv.

Mon. Nov. 23 - ARRIVE TEL AVIV/TIBERIAS

Arrive at Tel Aviv airport, where we will be welcomed by our tour guide and bus driver. Drive to our hotel by the Sea of Galilee in Tiberias. Mass of thanksgiving after dinner. Overnight in Tiberias.

Tues. Nov. 24 - SEA OF GALILEE/MAGDALA/CAPERNAUM/MT. OF BEATITUDES/TIBERIAS

Today, we visit Tiberias and the sites around the Sea of Galilee. Celebrate Mass at the beautiful Church in Magdala. Visit Tabga - the site of the miracle of the Loaves and Fishes. Stop at St. Peter's Primacy before proceeding to Capernaum - the second home of Jesus. Pray and reflect on the Mt. of Beatitudes. After lunch, we visit Yardenit River Jordan where we can renew our baptismal vows. Overnight in Tiberias.

Wed. Nov. 25 - SEA OF GALILEE/NAZARETH/CANA/MT. TABOR

This morning, we enjoy a 2-hour boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. We will pray The Angelus together at the Basilica of the Annunciation and visit St. Joseph's workshop. Continue on to Cana where we can renew our wedding vows. After lunch, we ascend Mt. Tabor and celebrate Mass at the Church and Monastery of the Transfiguration and enjoy a magnificent view of the Jezreel Valley. Enjoy an evening prayer meeting on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. Overnight in Tiberias.

Thur. Nov. 26 - CARMEL/CAESAREA/JERUSALEM

This morning, we will celebrate Mass on Mt. Carmel (Muhraqa) where Elijah fought against the prophets of Ba'al. Continue on to Caesarea by the Sea and visit the ancient Roman Theater and aqueduct where we stop for pictures and playtime by the Mediterranean Sea. We continue traveling to the golden city of Jerusalem where we celebrate a memorable Thanksgiving with grateful hearts! Overnight in Jerusalem.

Fri. Nov. 27 - BETHLEHEM/JERUSALEM

This morning, visit Shepherds' Field where we will celebrate Mass recalling the angels' announcement of Christ's birth! Fulfilling the scripture that every knee shall bow, we pray at the site of Christ's birth in the Church of the Nativity. Enjoy an exotic lunch and a chance to shop in a Bethlehem Olive Wood store. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Sat. Nov. 28 - OLD CITY TOUR/VIA DOLOROSA

Walk along the Golden Gate to the Old City. Visit the Church of St. Anne, Pools of Bethesda, Ecce Homo - Lithostrotos (stone pavement) where the Game of the Kings is inscribed, marking the place where Jesus was mocked. After lunch, we walk the Via Dolorosa as we follow the Stations of the Cross and have personal prayer and reflection on our Savior's life, death and resurrection in this most holy of holiest places, the Church of the Holy Sepulcher where we will leave our prayer petitions on Mount Calvary. Celebrate Mass in the Church of the Holy Sepulchere. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Sun. Nov. 29 - BETHANY/QUMRAN/JERICO/DEAD SEA

Today, we will celebrate Mass at the Church of Mary, Martha and Lazarus in Bethany. We drive for an amazing view of the Judean Desert. Continue to old Jericho and Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Then, drive to the earth's lowest land point to have fun floating on the salty Dead Sea. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Mon. Nov. 30 - JERUSALEM

Visit the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu (cock crowing) and Caiphas' House to see the area where Jesus was tried by the Sanhedrin and examined before the council. After lunch, stop at the traditional site of Emmaus where Jesus broke bread with his disciples after the Resurrection. We proceed to Ain Karem, birthplace of John the Baptist, where we will celebrate Mass at the Church of the Visitation. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Tues. Dec. 1 - JERUSALEM

Today we visit Dominus Flevit where Jesus wept over Jerusalem, then proceed to the Mt. of Olives for a beautiful panoramic view of Jerusalem and walk the path of Palm Sunday. Spend an hour in prayer in the Hermitage Garden before celebrating Mass at the Church of All Nations. This afternoon we visit King David's tomb on Mt. Zion and pray in the Upper Room, the traditional site of the Last Supper and the descent of the Holy Spirit. Return to our hotel for some leisure time, visit the Pentecost Room at the hotel or enjoy shopping at the old city bazaars. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Wed. Dec 2 - WESTERN WALL/SOUTHERN STEPS/CITY OF DAVID/ HEZEKIAH'S TUNNEL

We begin our day with an early Mass in the Notre Dame Chapel then on to the Western Wall and tunnel tour alongside the Wall with all its amazing history unfolding daily. Ascend the Southern Steps which lead to the Temple in the time of Christ. We will see a 3D presentation on the City of David and continue to Warren's Shaft to take a fun trek through Hezekiah's Tunnel before visiting the exciting new excavations at the Pool of Siloam. Rest of the day at leisure. This evening, we will enjoy a special Farewell Dinner before departing to the airport for our direct flight to LAX.

Persons using C-pap machines requiring distilled water will need to inform us ahead of time, so we can work with local operators to prepare as it is not always available.
