Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we celebrate the feast of Christ, King of the Universe. This feast in the pre-Vatican II Rite was celebrated at the beginning of the month, but since, the church has moved the feast to the last Sunday of the church year. There is something fitting about this, as we end the year with the way that our salvation itself will end – with Christ as King, laying His kingdom and all His subjects – us – to the Father.

A few years ago, I researched a little on how kings were made in the Old Testament and the cultures around them. We might be aware of the kingly line – the blood-line. Jesus is a descendant of King David and has a claim to the throne. Kings were made by victory in battle – Jesus won the war over the ruler of this world, Satan and conquered sin and death. Kings were sometimes made by marriage – and Jesus 'marries' heaven to earth in His Incarnation. Last, kings were made by popular acclaim. This is where He may not be king – we need to claim Him! That's the reason for this feast, to remind us that we proclaim Him as our King and Lord.

But this proclamation should be more than just words. We proclaim Him as Lord when we seek to destroy sin and sinful tendencies and temptations in our lives and help others seek grace. He is proclaimed Lord when the poor are fed and clothed and comforted, the sick cared for and visited, the imprisoned are visited and treated with justice. When we seek to live the Corporal and Spiritual works of Mercy, we not only say He is Lord but we prove it with those simple deeds. And when we do, all will see the light of Christ and give glory to God.

This week, we will celebrate the national holiday of Thanksgiving. While not a 'feast' in the Church, it is a profoundly Christian foundation. We are to give thanks to God every moment of our lives. This holiday is a reminder to do so. Of course, as a Catholic, I cannot help but recall that the most perfect prayer – the Mass – is the Mass because we celebrate the Eucharist – which means thanksgiving. We will have a Mass on Thanksgiving Day at St. Eloi, and St. Edward's will host an ecumenical prayer service on Wednesday evening – yours truly will be preaching with a message that hopefully will be appropriate for these years.

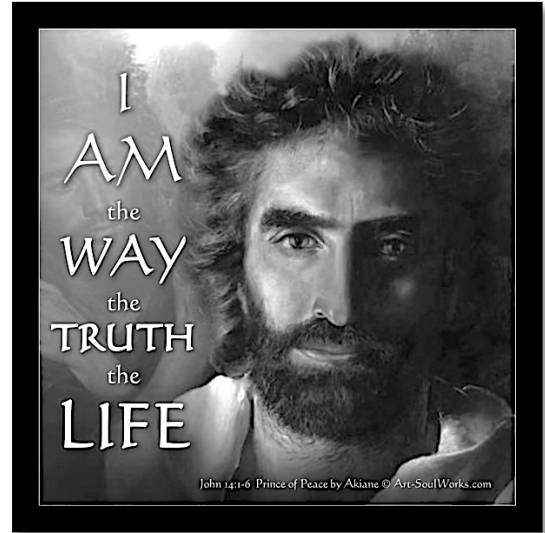

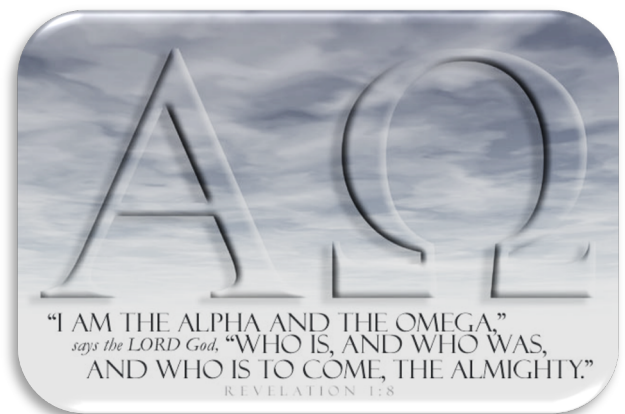
