## Helpful Hints

If there are two consonants following a vowel in a multi-syllabic word (and the consonants are not a Blend or Digraph), the consonants will split. One consonant will stay with the first vowel, and the other consonant will move on to be with the vowel in the next syllable. "Two must split."

example- rabbit rab/bit campus cam/pus

If a word ends in a *ch* or *sh* Digraph, the plural ending *-es* must be added. The sound for *-es* is /iz/ (e.g., *dresses*, *buzzes*, *boxes*). If a word ends in the *ph* Digraph, just add *-s* to make a plural.
