If you are unable to pick them up on that day and time, they will be available in the Parish Offices on or after Monday, July 15, for three months. We will not be able to store them longer than October 15.



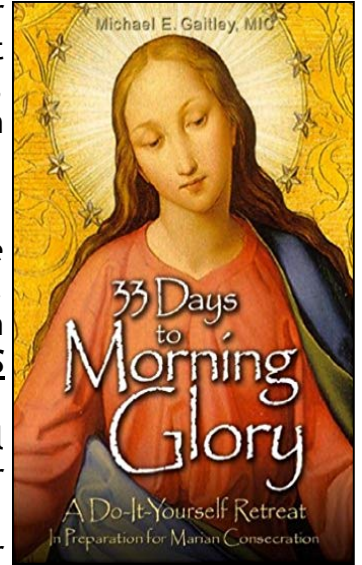
