Dear Parishioners,

The school year seems to be off to a great start! We had a lovely opening Mass despite an unwelcome guest who disturbed and frightened a few. It will probably be a Mass to remember as a few had to dodge the bat. All the more reason to seek the bat eviction process.

Monday noon I had another appointment at the heart clinic in Sioux Falls. All things considered, I am doing okay. They did prescribe another medication that may help. My EKGs remain abnormal, and the ejection fraction is in the 38% range (60% is ideal). The new medication is supposed to help with the symptoms of heart failure which technically I have. I remain able to exercise and even can run (though I limit it to two sessions of 15 minutes each, separated by walking, three times a week). I will not have to return, unless something changes, until next August. This is good news.

As we gear up for another year of Religious Education, I wish to encourage more adults to consider being a catechist. There might be a fear to do so, but so often we learn by doing, and the books for our catechists are helpful and the programs are well laid out. I am so thankful for all who have volunteered for this important role.

Catechists, however, only are assistants – it is the role of the parents to be the teachers of their faith. As we pray in the Baptismal rite, fathers and mothers are the first teachers of their children in the ways of faith. The school and RE programs are only part of that. Mass attendance is a core part of this formation, but also entails prayers as a family such as meal prayer, night prayer, and prayers for travels, for example. Having religious images in the home – especially the Sacred and Immaculate Heart or the image of Divine Mercy – reinforce the importance of the faith.

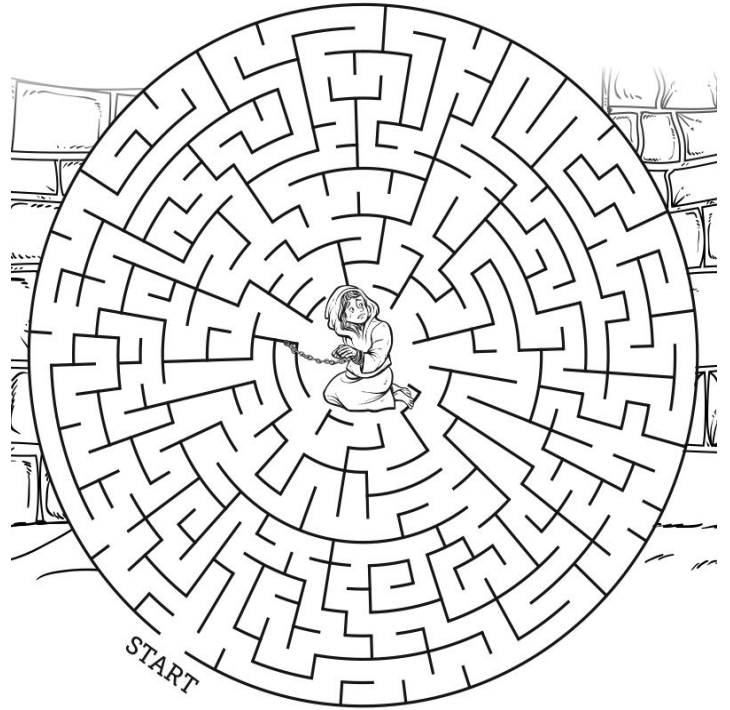

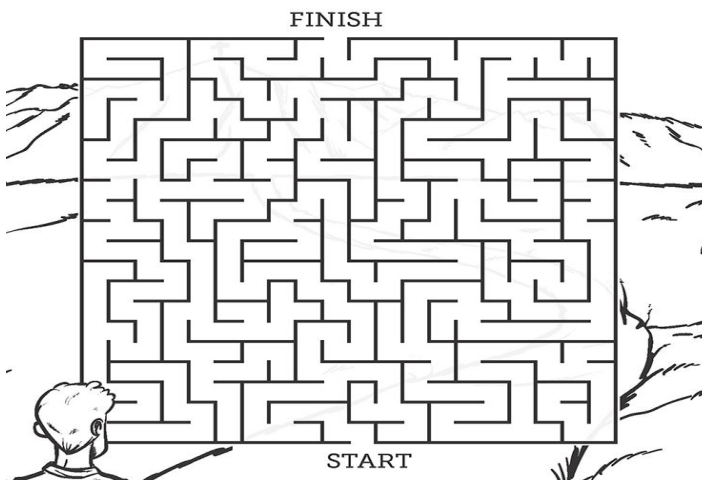
