LSAT Opening

Mr. Shell reported collegial and collaborative meeting on 2/23/21.

Mr. Little opened meeting for question and comments.

I. Budget Updates

Staff asked about developments in budget meeting. Notes will be posted on school website and WTU group by COB Thurs.2/25.

Staff expressed concern about not having a DSI allocation and need to ensure compliance, student support and community connections.

Principal Little indicated that the team is advocating for compliance support. Principal will share staff direction/plan before the school budget is submitted.

II. **FY22 Personnel and Non-Personnel Allocations** – closed session.

LSAT discussed SEL Department. Team discussed allocated positions, rationale for term of positions (ex:11 mo. Vs. 12 mo.), department additions to support need, intent of existing roles and restructuring of roles/responsibilities to support social emotional well-being and safety; Team inquired about job description for Restorative Justice Coordinator. Mr. Little will provide that job description.

- LSAT expressed need for additional bilingual SEL staff however these position descriptions do not exit and would therefore be placed under a regular position. Such positions have been difficult to locate in the past and would need to be heavily searched for during hiring. Note: If additional staff is placed on the budget and no bilingual staff is found the school will need to hire a non-bilingual person, be given a person from central office or attempt to reprogram the position prior to the deadline.
- Behavior positions were discussed. Noted that there is a need for someone to support and reenforce positive behaviors; will revisit.
