“Right to Know” Notice

On January 8, 2002, the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (NCLB) was signed into law. Section 111 l(h)(6) (A) states that parents of students in a school receiving Title I funds have the right to know the professional qualifications of the classroom teachers instructing their child. Federal law requires the school division to provide parents this information in a timely manner should they request it.

Since Rappahannock County Elementary School receives Title I funding, parents of students in Rappahannock County Elementary School, have the right to request the following information about each of their child's classroom teachers:

- Whether the teacher meets the state qualifications and licensing criteria for the grades and subjects that he or she teaches,
- Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or provisional status because of special circumstances,
- The teacher's college major, whether the teacher has any advanced degrees, and the filed discipline of the certification of the degree, and
- Whether paraprofessionals provide services to your child and, if so, their qualifications.
